Participants will develop skills to identify, rescue, and rehabilitate victims, while understanding the roles of stakeholders like law enforcement, the judiciary, NGOs, and citizens. Emphasizing a victim-centric approach, the course uses discussions, case studies, and simulations to promote systemic change and effective engagement in the fight against modern slavery and for victim justice and rehabilitation.

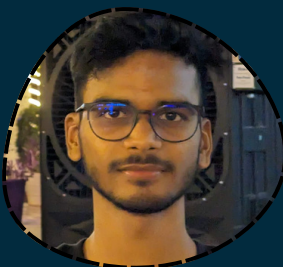
