Main Case

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner is a Covid -19 warrior who acquired the kidney disease when he was posted in the laboratory after the onset of Covid – 19 epidemic. He has submitted that although the petitioner has been enrolled in the list of kidney transplant patients by the PGI but according to the learned counsel for the petitioner, the same is not in consonance with the Transplantation of Human Organs and Tissues Rules, 2014 and particularly Rule 31. He has further submitted that being a Covid – 19 warrior, the petitioner ought to have been given priority as compared to other patients.
