Contention is that the dispute, at best, is a commercial dispute and the petitioners are willing to have it resolved by way of mediation.

Sri Navin Sinha, learned senior counsel assisted by Sri Raghuvansh Mishra and Sri Ritu Raj Srivastava, learned counsel appearing for petitioners fairly states that in order to establish the bonafide of the petitioners, they would deposit a sum of Rs. 15 lakhs with the Registrar General of this Court, which shall remain subject to the outcome of the mediation proceedings. The petitioners shall also deposit costs with the mediation centre of Rs. 15,000/-, within two weeks.

The mediation centre shall issue notices to the parties and make all endeavours to conclude the proceedings within a period of two months, thereafter. For a period of three months, no coercive action shall be taken against the petitioners.
