Today, State counsel has produced the custody certificate dated
04.02.2025, which is taken on record.

After hearing the learned State counsel in CRM-4007-2025, this
Court finds no cogent reason for recalling the order dated 21.01.2025 wherein
Dr. Ashwani Kalia, Director, FSL, Punjab had in clear words admitted to have
been short of funds/expenses to purchase the requisite equipments for the
three Regional FSL's located at Bathinda, Amritsar and Ludhiana. Therefore,
CRM-4007-2025 stands dismissed.

Application stands disposed of.

Meanwhile, an affidavit dated 05.02.2025 of Sh. K.A.P Sinha,
Chief Secretary to Government of Punjab has been filed today in the Court
and the same is taken on record. Learned State counsel while referring to Para
8 of the affidavit seeks extension of time to comply with the order dated
21.01.2025, the relevant para is reproduced hereinbelow:-

“8. That in order to ensure compliance of the order 21.01.2025 passed by this Hon'ble Court, the requisite information has been sought by the Department of Home Affairs from the concerned offices. To this, the Department of Public Relation, Punjab has informed that the required information can be generated after going through voluminous record, hence they have requested to provide sufficient time to compile and present the requisite information. As such, the Department of Home Affairs has requested that Department of Public Relation, Punjab may be given sufficient time to compile and present the requisite information. It is further submitted that the Department of Home Affairs has directed the Director General of Police, Punjab to provide the justifiable requisite information in order to ensure the compliance of the order of this Hon'ble Court.”

Considering the submissions made in Paragraph 8 of the affidavit that this information that has been sought by this Court needs to be complied after collecting it from various sources and Departments of the State Government spread through the State which is a time consuming process therefore on considering the aforesaid request to be genuine and *bona fide*, one last opportunity of 04 weeks is granted to the Chief Secretary to Government of Punjab for furnishing necessary information before this Court by way of his own affidavit.

Needful be done on or before 07.03.2025.

The said affidavit along with the necessary information shall be filed in the Registry 03 days prior to the next date of hearing with an advance copy to the learned counsel for the petitioner.

To come up for further consideration on 11.03.2025.

Interim order to continue till the next date of hearing.
