Learned Advocate General for the State of Punjab has submitted that an assurance was given on 01.08.2025 in the Court by the counsel representing the State that till the decision of the case, the functionaries of the State of Punjab will not finalized the e-tender notices bearing tender ID 2025 WR 142217_1, 2025 WR 142217_2, 2025 WR 142217_3, 2025 WR 142217_4, 2025 WR 142127_1, 2025 WR 144376_1, 2025 WR 144315_1, 2025 WR 144316_1, 2025 WR 144314_1, 2025 WR 144145_1, 2025 WR 144114_1, issued by Water Resources Department, Government of Punjab.

Learned Advocate General, Punjab has prayed that keeping in view the situation in the State of Punjab owing to recent floods, the finalization of the aforesaid e-tenders is necessary for the purpose of de-silting and as such seeks permission of the Court for that purpose. He has further assured that finalization of aforesaid e-tenders shall be carried out in consonance with and in terms of guidelines dated 12.07.2023 issued by Government of India Ministry of Environment and Climate Change (Annexure R-4) and also the Detailed Project Report (Annexure R-8) dated 29.12.2023.

After hearing the learned counsel representing the parties, considering the present day situation owing to the floods in the State of Punjab and in the interest of justice and also taking into account the aforesaid assurance of learned Advocate General Punjab, this Court subject to outcome in this petition allows the

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State of Punjab and its functionaries to proceed further towards finalization of impugned e-tenders (Annexure P-3) subject however to the strict adherence to guidelines laid down by Government of India Ministry of Environment and Climate Change dated 12.07.2023 (Annexure R-4) and also Detailed Project Report dated 29.12.2023 (Annexure R-8).
