Since this Court on February 12, 2024, had passed directions as embodied therein and with said directions remaining yet uncomplied with, thus by all the respondents concerned, therefore, the said directions be ensured to be complied, but within four weeks hereafter.

An argument is made by Mr. Aggarwal appearing on behalf of State of Uttar Pradesh, that on account of insufficient releases of funds, for the relevant purpose, by the State Government concerned, thereby boundary pillars falling within the territories of the State of Uttar Pradesh, rather cannot be erected in terms of the survey marks assigned by the officers of the Survey General of India.

However, financial grants in the said regard be forthwith released, inasmuch as, within a period of three weeks from today, so that the work of erection of boundary pillars both within the States of Haryana and Uttar Pradesh becomes completed within a further period of four weeks.

Compliance affidavit on behalf of State of Haryana be also filed within a period of four weeks.
