MANAGING COMMITTEE GURU NANAK COLLEGE AND ANOTHER
VS
PANJAB UNIVERSITY AND ANOTHER

Present: Mr. Sangram Singh Saron, Advocate, and
Ms. Kimreet Khurana, Advocate, for the petitioners.

Through the instant writ petition, as cast under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, a prayer is made for issuance of a Mandamus upon the respondents to pass appropriate directions to all its affiliated Colleges to install CCTV cameras in their Examination Centres, and ensure compliance of such direction, or not to designate such affiliated Colleges as Examination Centres, which do not have CCTV cameras in the Examinations Centres.

Learned counsel for the petitioners, while relying upon Senate proceedings dated 03.06.2023 (Annexure P-1), 25.11.2023 (Annexure P-6), and the recommendations of the Committee dated 05.09.2023 (Annexure P-2), *inter alia*, contends that the directions (supra) ought to have been implemented uniformly, whereas, the respondent-University is implementing it in a discriminatory manner.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Inder Preet Singh, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents, and waives service. He prays for an adjournment to have apt instructions from the quarter concerned, and also to file reply to the instant writ petition.
