Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that both the impugned orders are totally non-speaking, especially the order passed by the appellate authority i.e. the Commissioner, Hisar Division, Hisar. While referring to para No.5 of the impugned order, he submitted that it was so stated by the Commissioner, Hisar Division, Hisar, that she has thoroughly studied and examined the facts on the file and the records and thereafter, passed a totally non-speaking and cryptic order without giving any reasons.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Udit Garg, Addl. A.G., Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State and has prayed for some time to file reply in the present case.

After perusing the aforesaid impugned order (Annexure P-4) passed by the Commissioner, Hisar Division, Hisar, it is directed that the Commissioner, Hisar Division, Hisar, shall file her own reply by way of an affidavit before this Court and apprise this Court as to what she has thoroughly studied and examined, as stated by her in para No.5 of the impugned order (Annexure P-4) as there is nothing on the record to show the reasons assigned for dismissal of the appeal.

It is important to note that in a large number of cases such kind of orders are being passed by the appellate authority while exercising statutory powers without recording any reasons.

On the next date of hearing, this Court will also consider the appointment of any legal authority to provide lectures and training to the appellate authorities or other authorities exercising the statutory powers.

This Court has requested Mr. Udit Garg, Addl. A.G., Haryana, to apprise it on the next date of hearing as to whether he will be ready for providing training to the senior officers of the State of Haryana, who exercise statutory powers or not, to which he submitted that he will apprise this Court on the next date of hearing.

On the aforesaid issue with regard to imparting training to the senior officers of the State of Haryana, who exercise statutory powers, the Chief Secretary to the Government of Haryana, shall file his response, on or before the next date of hearing.
