1. Heard Sri Atul Dayal, learned Senior Counsel for the petitioner.
2. Sri _____, Advocate, has accepted notice on behalf of respondent nos. 1 to 3. He is not present in the Court and his junior colleague, _____, is present.
3. _____ is Chief Standing Counsel and has been allotted the revenue work. This Court is dealing with the revenue matters and he is not present. He has delegated the brief of Kanpur Development Authority to his junior colleague.
4. The Vice-Chairman, Kanpur Development Authority is hereby directed to remove _____, from panel counsel and appoint some responsible counsel who at least appears in the Court. The brief of Kanpur Development Authority should not have been argued by a delegatee counsel but by counsel who has been appointed by Kanpur Development Authority. If _____, has so much of work and he is not able to appear in the Court, he should not accept the brief of Kanpur Development Authority which is a semi government body.
