The Court made the following:

ORAL ORDER:

Heard Sri Srinivasulu Kurra, learned Counsel for the Writ Petitioner and Sri C. Srinivasa Baba, learned Standing Counsel for the Respondent Nos.2 & 3.

2. The present Writ Petition is filed seeking a direction to consider the Representation submitted by the Writ Petitioner dated 10.09.2024 for conducting a probe into an alleged scam in Parakamani, T.T.D through CID (Ex.P.4).

3. It is the contention of the Petitioner that one Sri Y. Satish Kumar, Assistant Vigilance & Security Officer, Parakamani has filed a Complaint on 29.04.2023 before the Station House Officer, Town-I Police Station, Tirumala (Ex.P.1). As a consequence of the Complaint, an FIR was registered bearing No.24/2023 dated 29.04.2023.

4. It is further submitted that after having conducted an enquiry, the Police have filed a Chargesheet implicating one Sri C.V. Ravi Kumar under Sections 379 and 381 IPC. This Chargesheet was filed in the Court of IInd Additional Judicial Magistrate of 1st Class, Tirupati on 30.05.2023. Learned Counsel for the Writ Petitioner has drawn the attention of this Court to the Proceeding of the Lok Adalat Bench at Tirupati dated 09.09.2023 (Ex.P.3) in Lok Adalat Case No.582 of 2023 which states that the de-facto complainant has voluntarily compounded the offence punishable under Sections 379 and 381 IPC and consequently, the accused is acquitted under Section 320(8) Cr.P.C.

5. Sri C. Srinivasa Baba, learned Standing Counsel for the Respondent Nos.2 & 3, submits that he has received the Written Instructions from Respondent No.2 but he is not happy with the same and seeks time to file Counter Affidavit. Let Counter Affidavit be filed within two weeks. The said Counter Affidavit shall also state about the Disciplinary Proceeding, if any, initiated against the Respondent No.5; and if it has been initiated, its outcome.

6. Having regard to the above facts, in public interest, this Court deems it appropriate to firstly suspend the Order of the Lok Adalat at Tirupati dated 09.09.2023 in Lok Adalat Case No.582 of 2023 in C.C.No.844 of 2023 in Crime No.24/2023 of I Town Police Station, Tirumala until further Orders.
7. Having regard to the facts and circumstances of this case, this Court deems it appropriate to *suo moto* implead the IG, CB-CID as Respondent No.6 in this Writ Petition. Registry is directed to make necessary changes in the Cause-title.
8. Registry is also directed to print the name of Government Pleader for Home in the Cause-list.
9. The IG, CB-CID, is directed to forthwith seize the entire record relating to F.I.R.No.24/2023 registered in Town-I Tirumala Police Station including the Proceedings before the Lok Adalat in Lok Adalat Case No.582 of 2023. The said Officer is also directed to seize the entire record from the TTD relating to the Board Resolutions, if any, and any other Proceeding made by any Official of the TTD and submit the same to the Court (properly sealed) for perusal before the next date of hearing through the Registrar (Judicial).
10. Registrar (Judicial) is directed to convey the gist of this Order and its copy to the IG, CB-CID forthwith for effective compliance.
11. Learned Counsel for the Writ Petitioner is directed to take out Urgent Personal Notice in respect of the Unofficial Respondent Nos.4 & 5 within three days from today and file proof of receipt of Notice within three days thereafter.
