ORDER

By means of the instant petition filed in the nature of Public Interest Litigation, the petitioner has sought the following reliefs which reads as under:-

"(i) issue a writ order or direction in the nature of mandamus commanding the state government to ensure that the teacher taught ratio in the schools run by the Basic Education Board is maintained which has suffered a steep fall due to the reason that the Resource coordination of teaching activity has been taken away from experienced hands and put into the hands of persons who lack the training and experience for successful discharge of the same. in the interest of justice.

(ii) issue a writ order or direction in the nature of mandamus commanding the opposite party to take a decision for reorientation of the teacher student ratio in Basic Schools and ensure for its steady maintenance for successful implementation of the Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009., in the interest of justice."

The Court finds that from the perusal of the pleadings, no particulars have been furnished. Vague assertions have been made. Moreover in the light of the averments made in the petition, it cannot be said that any subsisting cause of action is made out.

In view of the aforesaid, we are not inclined to entertain the aforesaid petition, consequently, the petition is dismissed.
