1. The limited relief sought by the petitioner is that the respondent no.2 (Joint Commissioner, Licensing) / the respondent no.3 (Government of NCT of Delhi) be directed to decide the pending application of the petitioner for issuance of an arms license. It is submitted that an application in this regard bearing No.ARML2023110118 was filed by the petitioner as far back as on 22.11.2023.
2. Learned counsel for the concerned respondents, who appear on advance notice, submits and undertakes, on instructions, that necessary decision on the aforesaid application shall be taken within a period of four weeks from today, under intimation to the petitioner.
3. The above redresses the immediate grievance of the petitioner. Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of in the above terms. The pending application also stands disposed of.



4. Needless to say, if the petitioner is aggrieved with the decision taken by the concerned respondents, he shall be at liberty to take appropriate remedies under law.
