2. The Application stands disposed of.

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3. Criminal Writ Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, 1950 read with Section 528 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (*hereinafter referred to as 'B.N.S.S.'*), has been filed on behalf of the Petitioners with the prayers that the Petitioner No. 1, namely, Mr. Kaushal Singh, who is the brother of the deceased and Respondent Nos. 2 and 3, namely, Mr. Sumit Singh and Mr. Anil Verma, respectively, who are the eye witnesses, have been harassed by the Police and therefore, Police be directed to give them protection and also that the investigations in FIR No. 515/2025 under Section 103(1) & 3(5) of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, registered at Police Station Kalkaji, be transferred from Delhi Police to CBI.
4. On advance Notice, learned ASC for the State has appeared and seeks



time to file a Status Report.

5. Let the Status Report/Progress Report be filed before the next date of hearing with advance copy to the opposite counsel.
6. Be listed on 16.09.2025.
7. In the interim, the Respondents are directed to conduct the investigations, in accordance with the provisions of B.N.S.S., 2023.
