	I.A.1/2024 is filed in W.A.No.1444/2023 by the appellants seeking directions to extend the time limit for enforcement of High Security Registration Plates to vehicles in Karnataka State expiring on 31.05.2024 as extended by the State Government in its Notification dated 16.02.2024. Heard Dr. Aditya Sondhi, learned Senior Counsel appearing for appellants in Writ Appeal No.1444 of 2023; Sri.Ruben Jacob, learned Additional Advocate General appearing for the respondent No.1 – State; and learned counsel appearing for remaining respondents. Dr. Aditya Sondhi, learned Senior Counsel appearing for appellants in Writ Appeal No.1444 of 2023 submits that the appeals were heard by this Court for sometime on 18.04.2024 and thereafter directed to be re-listed on 11.06.2024. It is submitted that in the interregnum, the time limit for affixing HSRP plates is going to expire on 31.05.2024, till which date it is extended vide Notification dated 16.02.2024. It is therefore submitted that if the aforesaid time limit which would expire on 31.05.2024 is not extended till disposal of the present appeals by this Court, the appeals would be rendered infructuous resulting in irreparable injury and hardship to the appellants and justice would suffer and as such, the appellants have filed the instant application – I.A.1/2024 for appropriate directions. Per contra, Sri. Ruben Jacob, learned Additional Advocate General on instructions submits that, even subsequent to 31.05.2024 and till 12.06.2024, the respondent No.1 – State would not take any further precipitative steps / action / decision in the matter relating to and regarding fixation of HSRP plates to vehicles in Karnataka pursuant to the State Government Notification dated 17.08.2023 and subsequent Notifications. It is also submitted that respondent No.1 – State would file objections to I.A.1/2024 by the next date of hearing. The aforesaid submission / undertaking made on behalf of the respondent No.1 – State is placed on record. The learned counsel for the other respondents also seek time to file objections to I.A.1/2024 by the next date of hearing. In view of the aforesaid facts and circumstances and submissions made on behalf of the respondent No.1 – State and the undertaking given by them that even subsequent to 31.05.2024, the respondent No.1 – State would not take any further precipitative steps / action / decision in the matter relating to and regarding fixation of HSRP plates to vehicles in Karnataka till 12.06.2024, the Registry is directed to re-list the matter on 11.06.2024.
