UNITED NATIONS HUMAN RIGHTS COUNCIL

The United Nations Human Rights Council (UNHRC) is a key United Nations body tasked with promoting and protecting human rights worldwide. Comprising 47 elected member states, it examines human rights violations, formulates policy responses, and encourages international cooperation to uphold human dignity and justice. Delegates deliberate on pressing global issues, draft resolutions, and engage in mechanisms such as the Universal Periodic Review to ensure accountability among all UN member states. By addressing discrimination, responding to humanitarian crises, and advancing rights-based dialogue, the UNHRC plays a vital role in shaping global human rights standards and fostering a more just and equitable world..

UNITED NATIONS FRAMEWORK CONVENTION ON CLIMATE CHANGE

The United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC) is a central international framework dedicated to addressing the global challenge of climate change. Bringing together nearly all nations of the world, it provides a platform for dialogue, negotiation, and cooperation to limit greenhouse gas emissions and strengthen resilience to climate impacts. Under the UNFCCC, states engage in developing climate policies, reviewing national commitments, and advancing mechanisms such as climate finance, technology transfer, and adaptation strategies. By fostering collective action and accountability, the UNFCCC plays a pivotal role in guiding global efforts toward sustainable development and a more climate-resilient future.

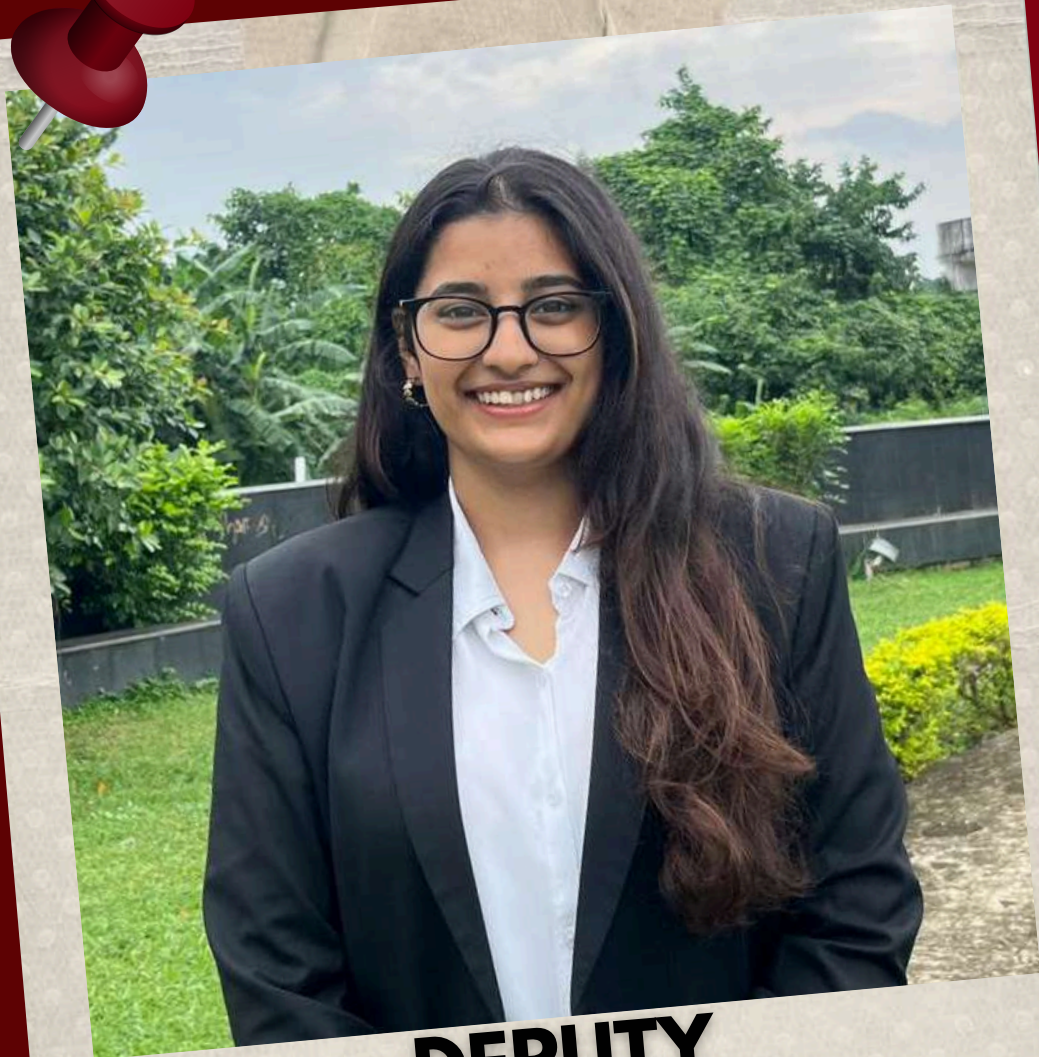
