1. Heard learned counsel for the petitioner, Sri Manish Goyal, learned Additional Advocate General assisted by Sri A.K.Goyal, learned Additional Chief Standing Counsel for the State.
2. The present writ petition has been filed by the Managing Committee of Noori Jama Masjid whose case is that the State is carrying out demolition of the mosque, which was constructed way back in the year 1839 on the ground of being an illegal construction.
3. The learned Additional Advocate General appearing on behalf of State has submitted that whatever excess construction or encroachment on the land of the State that was made to the original structure, has already been removed.
4. It is further categorically stated before this Court and we record that no further demolition of the mosque is required.
5. Under these circumstances, as no further demolition of the mosque is required and the rights of the petitioner can be protected adequately, if the petitioner applies under Section 24 of the U.P. Revenue Code, 2006 for demarcation of the boundaries, the same shall be carried out within the period stipulated in the statute from the date on which the application for

demarcation is produced.

6. With these directions, the petition stands **disposed of**.

7. Interim order, if any, passed earlier stands merged with this final order.
