Mr. Chanchal Shekhar, ADGP (S.C.R.B.).appearing through video conferencing informs that the sharing of A.P.I.s (Application Programming Interface) between the High Court of Madhya Pradesh and the CCTNS (Crime and Criminal Tracking Network & Systems) has been successful in the trial run. The information with regard to filing of petition under section 482, section 483 and section 528 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 is reaching seamlessly to the concerned police stations and the police stations are uploading case diaries in most of the matters.

Mr. Kuldeep Singh Kushwah, Registrar I.T.-C.S.A, High Court of Madhya Pradesh informs that a dashboard with regard to requisition and uploading of case diary has been prepared facilitating supervision of the process.

The Superintendents of Police have flagged minor issues, which relate to the data size permissible under CCTNS for uploading of documents and the time window available for uploading of case diaries after receipt of the intimation. The Technical

Teams of MPHC and SCRB shall address these issues to make the system efficient and seamless.

An '*Alert*' may also be provided on e-Rakshak App to the Superintendent of Police of concerned District and the S.H.O. of concerned police station with regard to requisition of case diaries. Mr. Chanchal Shekhar, ADGP (S.C.R.B.) submits that the CCTNS has been migrated on cloud. There are certain issues with regard to VPN (Virtual Private Network) connectivity to facilitate '*Alert*' on e-Rakshak App. However, he assures to take up this matter with M.P. State Electronics Development Corporation Ltd, to facilitate VPN connectivity for e-Rakshak.

After hearing all the concerned, **the matter is closed** with the following directions :

- i) The Registrar I.T.-C.S.A in consultation with the ADGP (S.C.R.B.) shall prepare project report and submit before the Computerization Committee of High Court of Madhya Pradesh at the earliest, preferably within 15 days.
- ii) If further test run is required, it may be taken up for requisition and uploading of case diaries for this Court.
- iii) The Commissioner of Police, Indore and the Superintendents of Police are expected to supervise the test run for online requisition and uploading of case diaries within their jurisdiction.
- iv) The State Government is expected to provide adequate bandwidth and seamless network at every police station.
