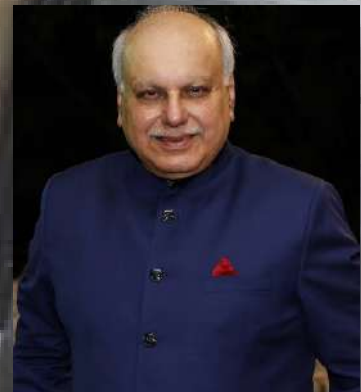

The Sultan-Ul-Uloom College of Law was established in the year 1989. It has made a mark as a premiere law college and has successfully completed more than three decades in educating young law aspirants. Presently the college is offering LLB (3YDC), BA,LLB(5YDC), BBA, LLB(5YDC), LLM (CORPORATE LAW) and LLM(CONSTITUTIONAL LAW).

ALTERNATE DISPUTE RESOLUTION(ADR).

Alternate Dispute Resolution (ADR) refers to methods of resolving disputes outside traditional courts, promoting amicable settlements with or without a neutral third party. Common ADR methods include:

- Arbitration– A formal process where parties present their case to an arbitral tribunal, which issues a binding and final award.
- Mediation– A non-binding process where a neutral mediator facilitates discussions to help parties reach a mutually acceptable settlement.
- Conciliation– Similar to mediation but with a more active role by the conciliator in suggesting solutions to resolve the dispute.
- Negotiation– A voluntary and direct discussion between parties to settle disputes without third-party intervention.

MEDIATION:

Mediation is gaining popularity due to its confidentiality, flexibility and effectiveness in resolving commercial, family, and workplace disputes. The mediator conducts private discussions and assists parties in reaching a fair and mutually beneficial settlement.

Hon'ble Supreme Court Judge Justice Sanjay Kishan Kaul once remarked that "It is my belief and I must say so that the mediation process is one of the better solutions to the problem". Since the mediation process is one of the most accepted solutions to the problem and to create awareness, we are conducting inter college Mediation Competition at Sultan-Ul-Uloom College of Law to create awareness on Mediation among law students.

GENERAL RULES OF THE COMPETITION

- Each team should consist of three people one mediator, one client and one counsel.
- There shall be two Teams competing against each other before the Judges.
- A Mediation Session shall comprise of six people wherein there shall be two Mediators and two Mediating Pairs (each Mediating Pair shall comprise of a client and a counsel).
- The Mediator(s) shall lead towards a settlement between the two disputing parties.

Breakup of time:

- a. Each session shall go on for a time period where:
 - i. Preliminary rounds shall be for 30 minutes,
 - ii. Semi-finals 45 minutes;
 - iii. Finals for 60 minutes.
- b. No extra time shall be granted. In case a Team exceeds the given time frame of the Mediation Session of any round, there shall be negative marking for exceeding every 1 minute.
- Private Caucuses
 - a. During the session, it is solely the discretion of the Mediating pairs to call for caucuses.
 - b. A caucus is private meeting between one party and the Mediators, 5 minutes per team.
 - c. However, the Mediating pair shall call for only one caucus in order to facilitate the mediation process.
 - d. Whenever the Mediating pair calls for a caucus, the other party shall leave the room.
- Carrying of books, electronic devices to the Mediation Room during the session is strictly prohibited. No audio or videotaping of Mediation Sessions is permitted. If participants indulge in any such activities they shall be disqualified from the competition immediately.



ELIGIBILITY

- Students pursuing their full time 3-year LLB or 5-year LLB program from a University or Institute recognized by the Bar Council of India, are eligible to apply.
- Only 1 Team per Institute shall be allowed to register for this Competition.

TEAM COMPOSITION

- A Team shall comprise of only 3 participants viz, Client, Counsel and Mediator.

LANGUAGE

- The official and only language of the Competition shall be English.

ROUNDS OF COMPETITION

- The Competition shall comprise of Qualifying Rounds and Advanced Rounds.
- The Qualifying Rounds shall consist of one Preliminary Round and the Advanced Rounds shall consist of two knock-out rounds viz, Semi-Final Round and the Final Round.

DRESS CODE

- The dress code for the Competition for both boys and girls shall be according to the BCI. Black and White Formals.
- The above-mentioned dress code extends to the Inaugural and Valedictory Ceremony as well.
