

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

General Guidelines

- All manuscripts and author(s) details must be submitted only via this form: (<https://shorturl.at/47Kcy>). Manuscripts sent via email will not be considered.
- The word limit, exclusive of footnotes should be 2000-3000 words.
- Please do not use any personal identification details in the manuscript, such as your name or institutional affiliations, to better facilitate the double-blind peer- review process.
- Co-authorship among individuals of the same or different institutions is allowed up to two authors.
- Please ensure that the manuscript submitted to us must not be simultaneously under consideration at other academic publications.
- Any manuscripts found to have a similarity index of more than 10% are summarily rejected. Other pieces depend upon context. Only the non-plagiarized manuscripts are sent to the peer reviewers.

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Formatting Guidelines

- Submissions should exclusively be made in “Word Document” only.
- The authors must follow the Bluebook 20th Edition format for citations.
- Please adhere to the following text formatting guidelines:
 - All text must be in black colour.
 - Main title: Times New Roman, Size 14, small capitals, center aligned, in bold.
 - Headings within the main body: Times New Roman, Size 12, upper case, left aligned, in bold.
 - Sub-headings within the main body: Times New Roman, Size 12, title case, left aligned, in italics.
 - We encourage lengthy articles to be divided into headings and subheadings for better structure. However, authors are advised to use only two heading levels.

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Formatting Guidelines

- Please number, format, and indent headings and subheadings as:

I. Heading of Chapter I

1.1 First Sub-Heading of Chapter I

1.2 Second Sub-Heading of Chapter I

II. Heading of Chapter II

2.1 First Sub-Heading of Chapter II

- The main body of the text: Times New Roman, Size 12, 1.5 line spacing, justified.
- Footnotes: Times New Roman font size 10, single line spacing, justified.

• Abbreviation of a word should only be done at the first instance and should not be repeated later. Please refrain from using terms such as “hereinafter” within the parentheses and do not use periods in these short forms.

For example: “The National Green Tribunal Act, 2010 (‘NGT Act’) is an Act of the Parliament of India which... The NGT Act was enacted to create a special tribunal to handle environmental cases.”

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Formatting Guidelines

- Writers should not use double quotations unreasonably. Only content used verbatim should be put in quotation marks.
- Speaking footnotes are strictly prohibited.

Editorial Policy

- The Editorial Board reserves the right to modify these guidelines at any point in time, without prior notice to the author(s).
- The decision of the Editorial Board in any dispute shall be final and binding.
- Upon final acceptance of the manuscript for publication by the Board, the copyright over the manuscript is vested with the Registrar, NLUJAA. However, the moral rights over the manuscript shall vest with the author(s).
