"To build a strong foundation, we need to clear the ground, let's start with clearing our minds"

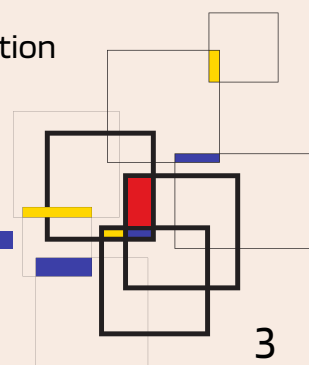
- Inclusion of all Alumni under one common forum i.e. the NLUJAA

SIGHTSEEING IN JODHPUR

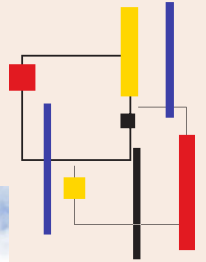


Mehrangarh Fort

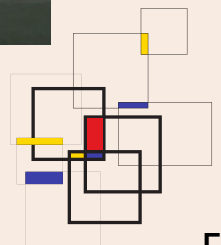
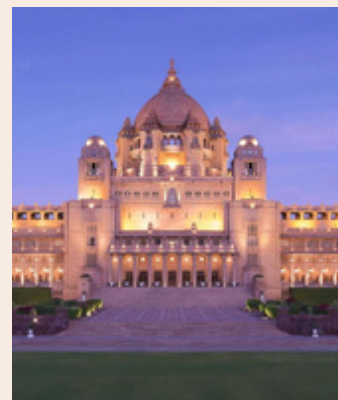


Toorji ka Jhalra

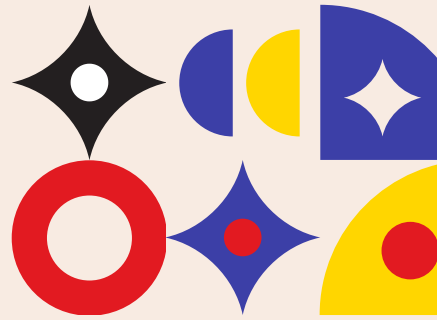
