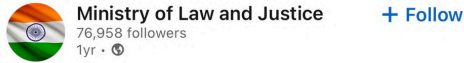
ABOUT NYAYA BANDHU

Through this program, practicing advocates who are willing to offer pro bono legal services are connected with eligible beneficiaries via mobile technology, ensuring access to justice for those in need. To further strengthen this network, the Department of Justice has proposed the establishment of Pro Bono Panels in every High Court, which will be curated and moderated by the respective courts. By integrating Nyaya Bandhu within the institutional framework of the justice system, the initiative seeks to maximize its impact and ensure the efficient delivery of free legal assistance across the country.

Best performing team in the **conclave** will be felicitated with:

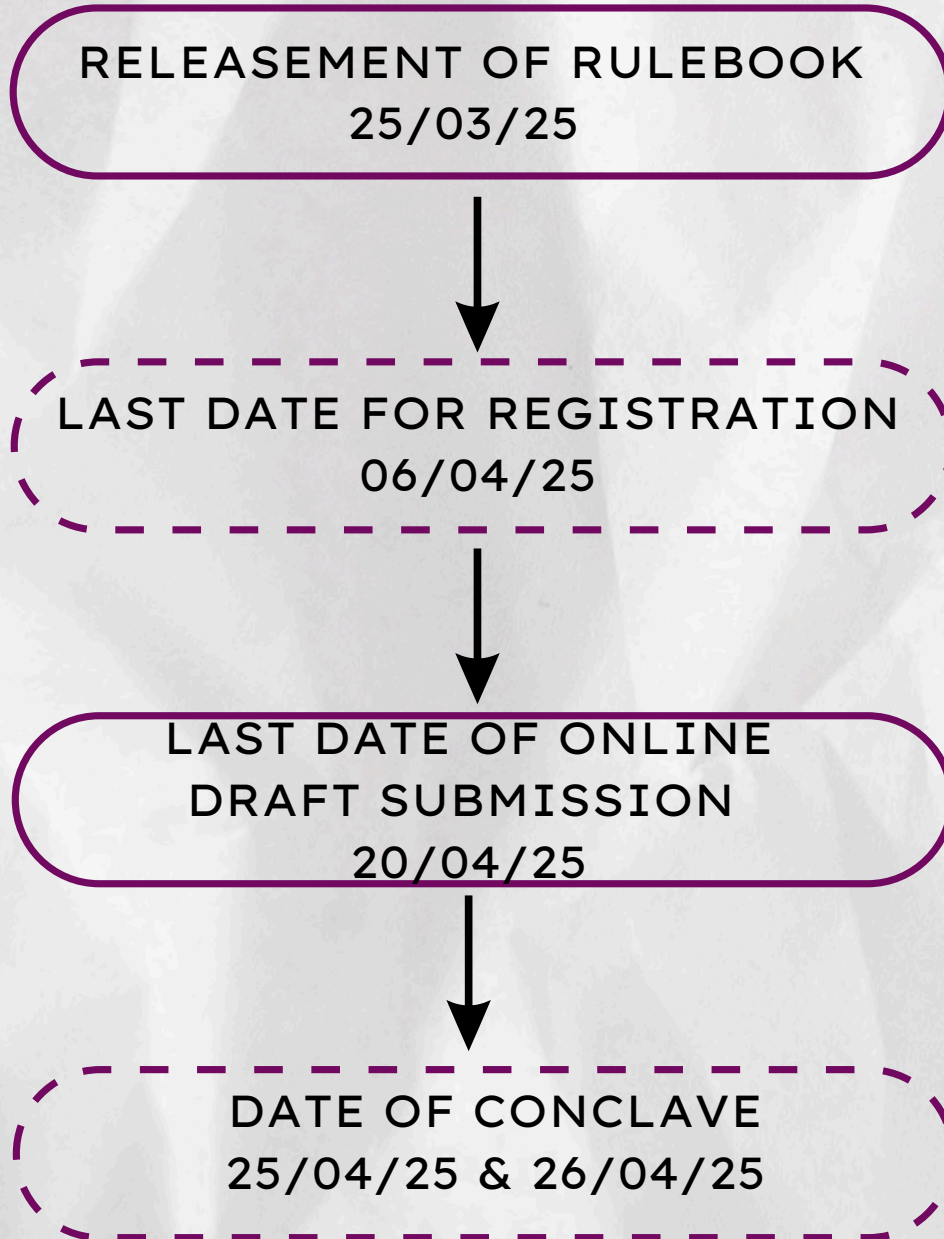
- WINNER : ₹ 7,000/- with Memento and certificate.

TEAM COMPOSITION

Pro Bono Club of each law school can send a maximum of two teams with five members. Students pursuing either a 5-year or a 3-year LL.B. degree from any Law School/College/University recognized by the Bar Council of India and is located in the **northern region of India** are eligible to participate. Team members must be bona fide students of the institution which they are representing. Each team may be accompanied with the Nodal Officer/Faculty (optional).
