1. This writ petition has been filed by the Bar Association of Motor Accidents Claims Tribunal, Mumbai to fill up the administrative staff in the Motor Accident Tribunal in a time bound manner.

2. In the affidavit in reply which was filed on behalf of the State Government on 4th July 2023, it has been stated that the State Government is taking steps to fill up the vacancies. The aforesaid stand taken by the State Government was disputed on behalf of the petitioner association by filing a rejoinder affidavit.

3. The motor accident claim cases are required to be decided expeditiously and, until and unless the adequate infrastructure is provided in the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, no speedy justice can be given to the victims of road accidents.

4. Learned Additional Government Pleader for the State has not disputed the aforesaid proposition and assured the Court that all effective steps shall be taken to fill up the administrative vacancies and a progress report in this regard shall be filed by way of an affidavit on or before the next date.
