O R D E R

1. It is urged before us that the Registrar has no power to refuse lodgment/registration of an application for recall, except for the three grounds stated in the Supreme Court Rules, 2013.

2. It is submitted that none of the grounds are applicable in the present case.

3 We have gone through the application (I.A. D.No.131074 of 2019) filed by the applicant-petitioner which the Registrar has declined to register.

4. The relief claimed in the said application, in our opinion, is unstatable. There can be no review

of an order passed in review petition. The fact that the applicant-petitioner was not heard before the order was passed in review petition cannot be the basis to file an '*application for recall*'. For, the review petition has been decided on merits by circulation in Chambers as per the practice and rules of this Court.

5. Accordingly, applications are dismissed.
