1. Mr. Tanveer Ahmed Ansari, who, appears on behalf of respondent no. 1/UOI seeks and is granted further three weeks to file a counter-affidavit.
2. I am informed by the petitioners that for the past three years, the Faculty of Law, University of Delhi, has not obtained the approval of the Bar Council of India.
3. Counsel for the Bar Council of India says that for grant of approval inspection has to be conducted and inspection is not conducted till such time requisite fee is deposited.

4. If this position, as articulated by the counsel for BCI, is correct, then, the University of Delhi will deposit the inspection fee within the next two weeks.
5. Upon the inspection fee being deposited, the BCI will carry out the inspection and take further steps for grant of approval to the Faculty of Law, University of Delhi.
