ORDER

In W.P.No.6695/2020, we issue notice to the respondents. Shri M.N.Kumar, learned CGC appearing for the Union of India takes notice. The learned Additional Government Advocate takes notice for the Government of Karnataka.

We direct the petitioner to serve notice to the third to sixth respondents by email calling upon the third to sixth respondents to appear before this Court for video conferencing hearing on 28th April 2020. A copy of this order shall be also forwarded by the petitioner to the third to sixth respondents.

We direct the third to sixth respondents to appear before the Court and to make a statement in what manner, immediate relief can be extended to the needy members of the Bar who are suffering due to lack of income.

In W.P.No.6696/2020, we issue notice to the first to fifth respondents. The learned Additional Government Advocate takes notice for the third to fifth respondents.

The petitioner will serve notice by email to the first and second respondents calling upon them to remain present before this Court on 28th April 2020 for video conferencing hearing. A copy of this order shall be also forwarded along with the notice issued by email.
