This writ petition has been filed by the petitioners on alleged atrocities committed by the police officials. The petitioners alleged that on 20.04.2020 in the evening time they were forcibly taken from their residence to a police booth nearby Sheetala Mata Mandir, Basai Darapur, Delhi and were beaten up and illegally retained. Later a false case was thrust upon both the petitioners.

However the FIR reveals the police had objected to the petitioner no.2's conduct of roaming in the locality without any mask and when asked about his conduct, he called his brother petitioner no.1 and then both petitioners had beaten up the police officials, for which the above FIR was also registered.
