CHIEF JUSTICE AND SACHIN SHANKAR MAGADUM	WP 6745/2020	29/05/2020	Perused the earlier order dated 22nd May, 2020. The learned counsel appearing for the Karnataka State Bar Council and the learned counsel appearing for the Advocates' Association of Bengaluru, state that a joint meeting was convened on 26th May, 2020 to discuss the issue. However, there is nothing concrete placed on record by both the entities to show that through the senior members of the Bar in the city, any fund is created to help the clerks who are in distress. We are sure that if the Karnataka State Bar Council and Advocates' Association Bengaluru make a request to the senior members of the Bar by inviting their attention to the plight of some of the advocates' clerks, contributions will come from senior advocates. The only question is of making an effort in the right direction. We are informed across the Bar that the Government of Telangana has released certain funds to help the junior members of the Bar who are in distress and even the advocates' clerks, who are in distress. The State Government will have to take a call and state before the Court what help the State Government can render to the needy members of the petitioner. To enable the Advocates' Association and the Bar Council to respond in a constructive manner, we are adjourning this petition till 2nd June, 2020 to be listed at 10.30 a.m., for Video Conferencing hearing. The response of the advocates shall be placed on record on that day.

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			While handing over the funds to the petitioner-Association, the members of the Bar can always impose conditions about the manner in which it should be used with a view to ensure that the clerks who are really in distress get the monetary benefit.

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
