The anxiety of the Court is to know as to how, now almost after two and a half months of the first lockdown, the State is proposing to go in for random testing.

Sri Manish Goyal, learned Additional Advocate General assisted by Sri A.K. Goyal, learned Additional Chief Standing Counsel has submitted that India being a welfare nation, with limited resources, is not in a position to go in for random Covid-19 testing. Sri Goyal further submitted that there is a protocol for actually allowing a person to get tested.

However, the Court upon seeing that the Covid-19 infection is increasing everyday in the State of U.P., is keen to know whether random testing is possible and what is the actual cost of Covid-19 testing for one particular individual.
