1. The hearing was conducted through video conferencing.
2. At the request of learned counsel for the petitioner, Government of NCT of Delhi is impleaded as a respondent. Let amended memo of parties be filed within two days.

3. Issue notice. Mr. Jasmeet Singh, learned CGSC accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.
4. Learned ASG appearing for the respondents submits that the ban on export of the PPE kits and medical masks has been imposed to prevent any shortage in the country. She submits that as per her instructions there is no dearth of buyers, however, the petitioner and other similarly situated manufacturers are wanting to export for making financial gains and not for the reason that there is any shortage of demand in the country.
5. She prays for time to file a counter affidavit. Let the same be filed within two weeks.
6. List on 10.07.2020.
7. On petitioner filing the amended memo of parties, notice shall issue to the newly added respondent, in addition through the Standing Counsel, Government of NCT of Delhi.
8. Copy of the Order be uploaded on the High Court website and be also forwarded to learned counsel for the Parties through email.
