COUNTER AFFIDAVIT FILED BY THE RESPONDENT NO.1

I, Srimanto Sen,

Secretary, Bar Council of India, C/o 21, Rouse Avenue Institutional
Area, Near Bal Bhawan, New Delhi do hereby solemnly affirm and
sincerely state as follows:

1. I am the Deponent herein and presently, I am working as Secretary, Bar Council of India, New Delhi and I am well acquainted with the facts stated infra.
2. I submit that, I have read the affidavit of the petitioner filed in support of the Writ Petition and I deny all those allegations, except those that are not specifically admitted hereunder and the petitioner is put to strict proof of the same.
3. At the outset, the 1st Respondent, Bar Council of India, herein humbly submits, that the petitioner in the writ of Mandamus under the light of facts and circumstances articulated in the writ affidavit is not warranted to be issued a writ of Mandamus in the present lis, as the main prayer of the writ petitioner purely comes under the domain of Academic issues. Hence, the writ petition itself is not maintainable in view of well settled legal principles by the Hon'ble Supreme Court and by this Hon'ble Court.

4. It is humbly submitted that Bar Council of India in short "BCI" is a statutory body established under section 4 of Advocates Act, 1961. The "BCI" regulates and represent the Indian Bar and Legal Profession. Bar Council of India performs the regulatory function by prescribing the standards of professional conduct and etiquette etc., "BCI" also regulates legal education by setting the standards for legal Education etc., The BCI resolved to conduct an All India Bar Examination "AIBE" that tests an Advocates ability to practice law. The All India Bar Exam is required to be passed within two years of enrolment, by all Advocates, who have obtained LL.B degrees/have graduated from the Academic year 2009-2010 onwards having obtained LL.B degrees with effect from 1st July, 2010. It is a pre- requisite for all similarly placed Advocates to pass All India Bar Examinations within two years of enrolment to be able to continue/remain in practice. After having successfully, cleared such exam, he/she will be entitled to a certificate of practice throughout India, though obtaining an enrolment certificate too, entitles an Advocate to practice throughout the territory of India, but clearance of this exam entitles a person to remain in practice after 2 years of such enrolment. It may be clarified herein, that if anyone practices in any particular state for a period upto six month, he/she has to necessarily obtain a transfer of registration certificate to be registered under such State Bar Council.

It is clarified herein, the said exam is not mandatory to be enrolled as an Advocate under Section-24 of the Advocates Act, 1961, but is mandatory to be able to remain/continue in practice after 2 years of such enrolment.

5. In fact, "BCI" has been updating all it's Academic schedules, Results of "AIBE" exams etc. on the official website of the All India Bar Examination of the Bar Council of India i.e.

<http://www.allindiabarexamination.com>. "BCI" is having regulatory powers in conducting evaluation of, declaring the Results of "AIBE" examinations by prescribing it's own Academic policies etc., according to it's vision and Academic wisdom. It is apt to mention that, conducting "AIBE" examinations, evaluating, declaring the Results are all comes under the ambit of Academic and professional domain of the Bar Council of India to maintain and keep up the Professional standards of Advocates.

6. It is submitted that, at present All India Bar Examination is being conducted by an Agency appointed by the Bar Council of India under the supervision of high powered Monitoring Committee chaired by Hon'ble Mrs. Justice Gyan Sudha Mishra, former Judge, Supreme Court of India.
7. It is to submit that the petitioner having enrolment number AP/219/2019 had appeared in AIBE XIV examination held on 15th September, 2019 vide AIBE Roll No. 6150682 at the examination centre i.e. GITAM University, Visakhapatnam , Centre Code-15.
8. It is to submit that the Monitoring Committee at its meeting held on 21.09.2019 considered the email dated 17.09.2019 received from exam conducting agency highlighting the issues and problems faced during All India Bar Examination-XIV held on 15.09.2019 at various examination centres. After thorough discussions, the Hon'ble Committee decided to withhold result of candidates, who had appeared in nine centres including GITAM University, Visakhapatnam, Centre Code No.15, where mass cheating was reported and accordingly result of petitioner who had appeared at GITAM University, Visakhapatnam, was also withheld along with the results of all the candidates who appeared at those nine centres. In fact, the Monitoring

Committee also accepted the request of the agency to take assistance from cyber expert for establishing alleged cheating at these nine centres.

The copy of relevant extracts of the minutes of Monitoring Committee Meeting dated 21.09.2019 are attached herewith as Annexure-A1.

9. The candidates were informed by uploading Notification No.AIBE/WS/150/2019 dated 22.11.2019 about withholding their result, at the above nine centres including GITAM University, Visakhapatnam by stating they are pending enquiry as per the direction of Hon'ble Monitoring Committee due to complaints relating to the examination held at those centres.

The said copy of the Notification is attached as Annexure-A2.

10. It is to submit that Monitoring Committee at its meeting held on 21.01.2020 considered the report of agency's representative of the exam centre and came to the conclusion that allegation of cheating and copying in all nine centres including GITAM University, Visakhapatnam is correct and stands established. The Monitoring Committee decided that result of the candidates who had appeared at all nine centres shall not be declared and candidates who appeared at these centres would stand cancelled. However, the Committee directed that candidates from these centres who had appeared and sat for the exams would be allowed to take next AIBE without submitting exam fee for AIBE-XV. However, it was further held that those candidates who had not sat for the exam/were absent shall have to pay fee and appear in the next AIBE as per norm. **The copy of the aforementioned minutes of the Monitoring Committee is annexed as Annexure-A3.**

11. I submit that, vide Notification No.AIBE/WS/155 dated 06.02.2020, it was notified that candidates belong to nine centres including Visakhapatnam who appeared for AIBE XIV held on 15.09.2019 will now have to take next examination i.e. AIBE XV without submitting the examination fee. The copy of the said Notification is attached as Annexure-A4. ✓
12. It is apt to mention that, candidature of the petitioner who appeared in GITAM University, Visakhapatnam stood cancelled in view of the decision taken by the Monitoring Committee in this regard with liberty to appear in the next AIBE without submitting any examination fee. It is pertinent to mention that petitioner is making wrong averment stating that vide Notification No.AIBE/WS/154 dated 06.02.2020 and Notification No.AIBE/WS/155 dated 06.02.2020 his result is/was withheld without any valid ground, reasoning and in violation of principle of natural justice whereas Notification No. AIBE/WS/155 dated 06.02.2020, it was notified that candidates would/were required to appear in next examination AIBE-XV without submitting the exam fee and Notification No.AIBE/WS/154 dated 06.02.2020 also notified that candidates falling under the category of missing/mismatch set code stood disqualified for AIBE XIV held on 15.09.2019 which is nowhere connected to the petitioner. The candidature of the petitioner has been cancelled on the basis of decision of the Monitoring Committee dated 21.01.2020 as Monitoring committee came to the conclusion that allegation of cheating and copying in GITAM University, Visakhapatnam is correct. The copy of the said Notification No.AIBE/WS.154 dated 06.02.2020 is attached as Annexure-A5. .
13. It is to submit that Notification No.AIBE/WS/158 List B dated 21.02.2020 relates to cancellation of candidature of those candidates, whose papers had an issue of incorrect set code/set

code mismatch and is not at all connected to the petitioner as his candidature had already stood cancelled by the decision of the Monitoring Committee dated 21.01.2020 on account of mass cheating at the Centre where the candidate had given his exam, and the entire Centre, where the Candidate had appeared to give in AIBE IV, as a whole had been cancelled. **The copy of the Notification No.AIBE/WS/158 dated 21.02.2020 is attached herewith as Annexure-A6.**

14. Pertinently, vide Notification No.AIBE/WS/164 dated 10.05.2020 schedule for next examination has been notified and it was informed that candidates who had appeared at the cancelled nine centres including GITAM University, Visakhapatnam are to be updated soon. **The copy of the said Notification No. is attached as Annexure-A7.** Thereafter, vide Notification No.AIBE/WS/165 dated 14.05.2020 it was informed that, the admit card of those candidates who appeared at the cancelled nine centres including GITAM University, Visakhapatnam for AIBE XIV would be released directly without paying examination fee for AIBE XV and without submitting any exam form for AIBE-XV examination. **The copy of the said Notification is attached as Annexure-A8.** ✓
15. It is to submit that, vide Notification No. AIBE/WS/166 dated 15.02.2020, it was again notified to remove any doubts, that candidates who had appeared at the cancelled centres for AIBE XIV on Sunday, 15th September, 2019, appearing for AIBE XV examination would not have to pay the examination fee for AIBE XV and/or neither fill up any form for appearing in AIBE XV, and the list of the cancelled centres and list of the candidates was also provided the links on the official website of the All India Bar Examination of the Bar Council of India i.e. <http://www.allindiabarexamination.com>. It is to submit that, the petitioners name is reflected at Sr. No.674 in the link, and he

is not required to pay examination fee for AIBE XV and he is also not required to fill up any form for appearing in AIBE XV examination. The copy of the said Notification is attached as Annexure-A9.

16. The Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in it's Reported Decision (1970)-1-SCC-648 held that

"This is not a case of any particular individual who is being charged with adoption of unfair means but of the conduct of all examinees or at least a vast majority of them at a particular centre. If it is not a question of charging any one individually with unfair means but to condemn the examination as ineffective for the purpose it was held. Must the board give an opportunity to all the candidates to represent their cases? We think not. It was not necessary for the board to give an opportunity to the candidates if the examinations as a whole were being cancelled. The Board had not charged any one with unfair means so that he could claim to defend himself. The examination was vitiated by adoption of unfair means on a mass scale. In these circumstances it would be wrong to insist that the Board must hold a detailed inquiry into the matter and examine each individual case to satisfy which of the candidates had examination as a whole had to go."

17. The Hon'ble Supreme Court way back in the year 1984 itself held in Maharashtra State Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary Education & Anr. vs. Paritosh Bhupesh Kumar Sheth & Ors. has observed:

"As has been repeatedly pointed out by this Court, the Court should be extremely reluctant to substitute its own views as to what is wise, prudent and proper in relation to academic matters in preference to those formulated by professional men possessing technical expertise and rich experience of actual day-to-day working of educational institutions and the departments controlling them. It will be wholly wrong for the Court to make a pedantic and purely idealistic approach

to the problems of this nature, isolated from the actual realities and grass root problems involved in the working of the system and unmindful of the consequences which would emanate if a purely idealistic view as opposed to a pragmatic one were to be propounded.

Which supports our assertions, The said well settled legal Principle also reiterated by the Apex Court in its decision reported in 2014 (14) SCC 523.

18. In Bihar School Examination Board vs. Subhas Chandra Sinha and others, 36 students of a school moved the High Court under Article 226 against the order of the Board cancelling the annual secondary school examination of their centre and paying for a mandamus directing the Board to publish their results. The High court quashed the order of cancellation of examination and directed the Board to publish the petitioner's results. On the question of compliance of principles of natural justice it was found by the Supreme Court that in the case of adoption of unfair means by vast majority of examinees at particular centre, when the examination Board cancelled the examination as a whole at that centre, the opportunity to represent their case to all the candidates was not necessary before the cancellation order was passed. It was further held that if it is not a question of charging any one individually with unfair means, but to condemn the examination as whole, the board was not bound to give an opportunity of hearing to the candidates. The above legal principles also supports assertions of this Respondent.
19. I further submit that, I am filing the present preliminary counter affidavit basing on the material available with me at present, I crave leave of this Hon'ble Court to permit me to file additional counter, if necessary, in the interest of justice.

Extract minutes of Monitoring Committee All India Bar Examination of Bar Council of India meeting held on 21.09.2019.

" The Committee extensively considered the subject at Sl. No.2 of the letter of the agency dated 20.09.2019 under Item No.20/2019 along with Item No.21/2019 which discloses that the agency faced unpleasant and aggressive situations at the centres as the candidates were assisted to indulge in mass cheating for which certain applications also were installed on Mobile and large number of applicants were given assistance in copying the answers from online assistance through the application, which was installed. It was informed to the Committee that there is an application known as "TELEGRAM" which consists of a community of advocates and is a social platform of advocates which provides inputs, enters into discussions which is also capable to provide answers to the questions printed in the question paper sets.

What is intended to be conveyed is that the examinees through this application were assisted in getting the answers for the questions which were included in the question paper sets.

What is sought to be further explained, is that through this application, the answers to the questions in the printed form were provided through this application and thus, the students were provided assistance in copying those answers mechanically during the examination, which is the most gross form of cheating through this mobile application.

In support of this plea, the agency has submitted Annexure-1A, which discloses the facts and events that had taken place in the AIBE XIV

The Committee thus considered the letter of the Agency dated 20.09.2019 at Sl. No.2 whereby it has been explained how the agency faced difficult and unpleasant situations since the candidates appearing in the examination were assisted in mass cheating and the persons as also expert surveillance team who were deputed for conducting fair examination and checking such activities, were utterly helpless in controlling such activities.

The Committee while dealing with this complaint suffered by the Agency, divides them into two parts as follows:-

(i) The candidates were assisted in cheating and copying answers from an application known as Telegram. This incident was tracked at Rajiv Gandhi College of Law, Bhopal where one candidate was caught on the spot in such cheating through the application "TELEGRAM" and hence, his mobile was seized. Similar incidents of cheating and copying were found at

The Committee is of the view that the results of all the candidates who appeared in the aforesaid centres where mass cheating and copying is alleged for which evidence have been cited and discussed by the Agency, should not be declared and hence their results be put on hold.

The Committee is further of the view that the request of the Agency to take assistance from Cyber Expert for establishing the alleged cheating with the assistance of APP. be accepted. Consequently, the Secretary, Bar Council of India in pursuance to this decision shall issue a letter to the Agency permitting it to take assistance of the Cyber Experts in this regard whereby the Agency will furnish the names and addresses of cyber experts to the Secretary Bar Council Of India, which experts would be requested to investigate the incidents of cheating through the application "TELEGRAM" and report be requested to be submitted by the Cyber Expert to the Agency, which in turn will submit it to the Secretary, Bar Council of India and the same shall be placed before the Monitoring Committee after receipt of the same.

(ii) The Committee further took note of the Agency's complaint to the effect that several members of several State Bar Councils had created unpleasant situations for the Agency in holding the AIBE-14 peacefully, to such extent that it was practically impossible to hold the examination fairly.

The Monitoring Committee is of the view that the names of such members who created disturbances be furnished by the Agency to the Secretary Bar Council and the same be referred to the General House of the Bar Council of India, which will coordinate with the concerned State Bar Council communicating the grievance of the examination conducting agency and it is obviously the General House of the Bar Council of India which in our view would be in a position to take appropriate decision with regard to the erring members

(iii) In so far as the complaint regarding the allegation of cheating against individual candidates are concerned, the agency is directed to withhold the results of such candidates also and the same be placed before the Committee in its next meeting.

Extract minutes of Monitoring Committee All India Bar Examination of Bar Council of India meeting held on 21.01.2020.

The Monitoring committee considered report dated 24.12.2019 of the cyber expert on the investigation done on unfair means / mass cheating during AIBE XIV examination by using mobile phone/telegraph app etc. The report submitted by cyber expert states as follows:

1. Mass cheating was found at the center code 36 (Shri Ram Institute of Technology, Jabalpur, Madhya Pradesh) and centre code 25 (Sangam Modern Inter College, Allahabad, Uttar Pradesh).
2. Telegram App and WhatsApp was used for transmitting question papers by Manish Sharma, Shakti Singh from Hissar and Sanjay Dingra at the centre code 35 (Rajiv Gandhi Law College, Bhopal, Mahdya Pradesh).
2. Mobile phones were used by Shubhang Sharma at centre Code 2 (Kalinga University, Raipur, Chhattisgarh) to search for answers using Google Search engine.

Hence the allegations of cheating and copying as per video recording, finding of the report of cyber expert, report of the surveillance expert team of the exam centers and other documentary evidence are correct and stands established. In view of this authentication, the results of the candidates at following centers shall not be declared and the candidature of the candidates who appeared from these centers stand cancelled.
