1. This hearing has been held through video conferencing.
2. The Petitioners, who are appearing in the sixth semester examination in July 2020 seek directions from this Court that they be permitted to give their supplementary examinations for those exams which they have not passed in the first to fourth semesters.
3. The notification under challenge is of 22nd August, 2017 and the Petitioners have come belatedly to this Court. No interim relief has been sought by the Petitioners. In any case, the Court, at this stage, is not inclined to give any directions relating to supplementary examinations for the previous semesters as it is the stand of the University that the exams for the odd semesters i.e., first and third semesters are held along with the main examinations for the said semesters and separate examination cannot be

conducted for the said semesters during the final semester which is an even semester.

4. Delhi University shall file an affidavit explaining their policy for conducting supplementary examinations. Let the affidavit be filed within four weeks. Rejoinder, be filed within two weeks thereafter.
