In this petition various reliefs have been claimed by the petitioner as one of the life member of the petitioner association namely Sushri Achla Joshi had unfortunately expired on 05/09/2020. The allegation is that she was not given proper treatment and even the preliminary treatment was not given by the respondents No.6 and 7.

Shri Bhargava, learned Additional A.G. has informed that a PIL being WP No.13271/2020 has already been filed in respect of the same unfortunate incident and in that PIL the Division Bench today has passed an order for conducting a fact finding inquiry by the District Magistrate.

At this stage, the submission of counsel for the petitioner is that the interim relief in respect of preserving the relevant record be passed so that the matter can be fairly examined by this Court and even the fact finding inquiry will be facilitated by that.

Shri Bhargava, learned Additional A.G. prays for time to obtain instructions in the matter.

Meanwhile, let notice be issued to the respondents No.6 and 7 on payment of process fee within 3 days.

Till the next date of hearing, respondent No.4 is directed to ensure that the CCTV footage and all the documents relating to treatment of Sushri Achla Joshi from the hospitals of the respondents No.6 and 7 between period 05/09/2020 to

06/09/2020 are preserved.

Parties are also granted liberty to file an appropriate application in the pending PIL for analogous hearing of this writ petition.
