Heard Mr. S. Hegde, learned Senior Counsel through the virtual mode assisted by Mr. A.R. Bhuyan, learned counsel for the petitioner and Mr. D. Saikia, learned Advocate General, Assam assisted by Mr. B. Gogoi, learned Additional Advocate General, Assam for the State respondents.

Mr. Bhuyan, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner has submitted that he has received the detailed particulars of persons who have been picked up and who have been subjected to the alleged Pushback Policy adopted by the State. It is his submission that they were earlier on Indian soil, but, after being picked up their whereabouts are not known. He has submitted that he will file an additional affidavit furnishing the details of those persons on or before 14.07.2025.
