EVALUATION SYSTEM

The evaluation system at NUSRL, Ranchi comprises of examinations, research papers, viva, presentations, courtroom exercises and group projects. At the end of every semester, each student is marked out of a total of 100 for every subject.

Attendance

A student is required to be regular in classes and expected to have 100% attendance and condonation up to 30% can be considered for specific cogent reasons for making him eligible to appear in the End Term Examination of the concerned semester. No relaxation beyond 30% is considered in any case.

Grading System

At NUSRL, the students are evaluated on a ten-point Cumulative Grade Point System (CGPA). A student will be deemed to have completed the requirements for graduation if he/she has:

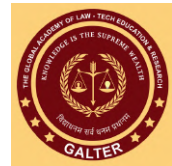

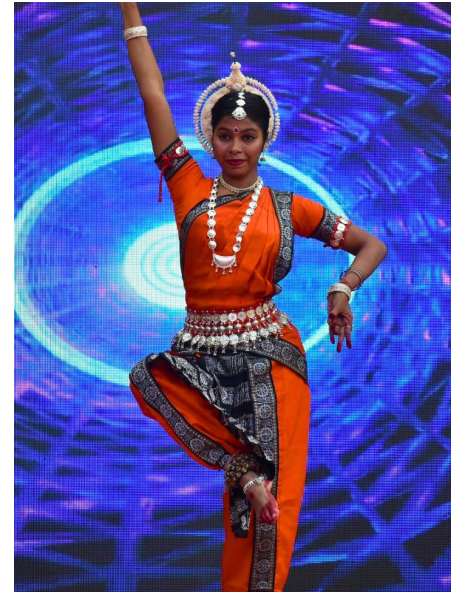

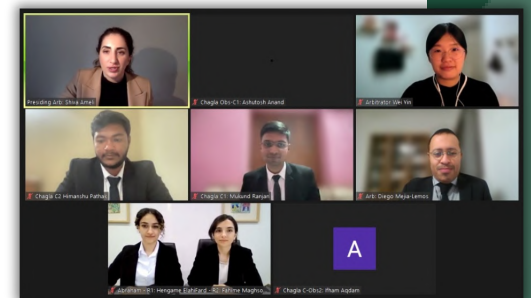

Initial Communication with the Recruiter

Screening & Interviews

The Recruiters may either themselves screen the CVs or may ask for any specific requirements of shortlisted CVs after which, the interviews of the shortlisted candidates will be arranged in person/virtually, as per the requirements of the Recruiters.

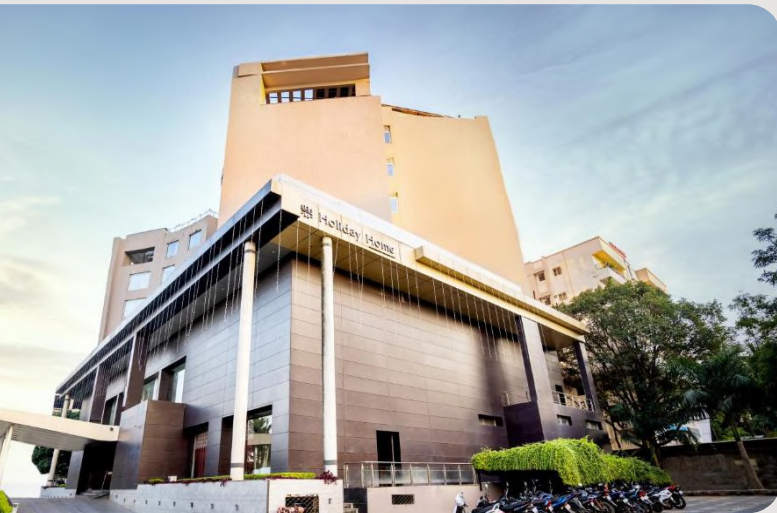

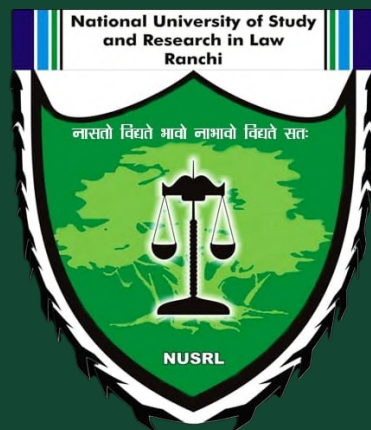
