

**Rajasthan State Legal Services Authority commenced the
implementation of “Srajan Ki Suraksha” – A scheme for eco-
feminism on 15.05.2025**
“सृजन की सुरक्षा” योजना

Recognizing the intrinsic link between the wellbeing of nature, revered as “Mother” for all beings and women worshiped as “Mother Power” (Matra Shakti) and acknowledging the disadvantaged position both face in contemporary society, the Rajasthan State Legal Services Authority launched a scheme for Eco-Feminism “Srajan Ki Suraksha” 2025, on 5th April, 2025 by **Hon'ble The Chief Justice of India Mr. B. R. Gavai**, & the then Executive Chairman, NALSA, in the august presence of **Hon'ble Mr. Justice Manindra Mohan Shrivastava**, The Chief Justice, Rajasthan High Court & Patron-in-Chief, RLSA & **Hon'ble Mr. Justice Shree Chandrashekhar**, Executive Chairman, RLSA.

Under the able guidance and directions of Executive Chairman, RLSA, Hon'ble Mr. Justice Shree Chandrashekhar, Rajasthan State Legal Services Authority has brought this ever first kind of initiative of eco-feminism, an unprecedented scheme and has not been thought by any legal services institutions. This scheme aims to empower women & protect environment through a collaborative and community centric approach, leveraging the existing legal services frame work.

Under patronage of Executive Chairman, RLSA, Mr. Hari Om Attri, Member Secretary, today launched the implementation of the scheme in selected 36 gram panchayats in 36 districts of the State of Rajasthan. A meeting was convened with all the stake holders comprising of DLSA Secretaries, sarpanch/panch of gram panchayats, higher officials of Forest Department, Health Department, Women and Child Development Department and Education Department. The Member Secretary discussed about the vision, coordination, monitoring and evaluation of the scheme with all the stake holders & good implementers of the scheme. The cross suggestions were invited during the meeting. The participants proposed to include “geo tagging” for all the saplings planted and reviewing the geo tagging after 06 months for efficacious implementation. It was also suggested to emphasize on nourishment of the girl child born, parallel to the planted saplings. The suggestions were duly discussed and measures have been brought in execution of suggestion by inviting the NGOs for collaborative support.

In furtherance of implementation of this scheme, all 36 DLSAs Rajasthan, have identified 36 gram panchayats, in 36 districts, on pilot basis, based on relevant socio-economic indicators & potential for community participation. 11 (Eleven) saplings are to be planted on the birth of every girl child in these 36 village panchayats. To illustrate the potential impact-In a village of 500 houses, assuming one girl child is born in each, the “Srajan Ki Suraksha” scheme initiative would introduce 5,500 trees, significantly transforming the village into a potential green centre.

The DLSAs have issued a special unique identity card to every girl child born within the selected gram panchayats. This unique identity card is going to symbolically link the girl child & family with available legal services and schemes of state government. This card will ensure proactive engagement with the families of “Green Girl” facilitating information & support regarding medical facilities & health care schemes, educational opportunities and relevant government schemes and available social protection programs. Also providing legal aid & assistance in case of need, particularly related to child rights, women’s right & POCSO offences.

The RLSA & DLSAs are working in close collaboration with all the stake holders, NGOs and community based organizations for effective implementation of the scheme.
