Respected Chief Justice,

Kindly refer to the letter dated: 10/11/2025 addressed to Registrar General, High Court of Gujarat by the then President of the Association Shri Brijesh Trivedi. I annex herewith the copy of the same for your ready reference. The situation thereafter has worsened and has gone out of control. The instances of dog bites to the litigants in December itself numbered to 4 or 5. Yesterday i.e., 05/01/2026 Radhesh Vyas a regular practioner of this court had to bare the brunt in as much as he suffered a dog bite. We had to rush him to the hospital where he was treated but the bite was so severe that doctor had to take stitches and was administered three injections and in all has to take eight injections. Two or three advocates have informed me that they had a very narrow and near escape. One advocate was surrounded by four stray dogs in the chamber building itself. I have witnessed dogs roaming freely outside the open area of the Hon'ble



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First Court. I would earnestly request you to be kind enough to forthwith ask the campus director or any officer whom your Ladyship deems fit to see that stray dogs are removed from High Court campus at the earliest. There is a lot of discontent and anger prevailing amongst the members of the bar because of uncontrolled movements of stray dogs in the premises of the High Court which endangers the physical safety and security of an advocate so also litigants and support staff of the advocates.

I hope and trust your Ladyship would act very fast and respect the sentiments and emotions of the bar which runs very high.
