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Minutes of Extra Ordinary General Body Meeting held on 17/01/2025 at 1:45 p. m. in Bar Room.

An extra Ordinary General Body Meeting was called on 17/01/2025 at 1:45 p. m. by Shri Brijesh Trivedi (President GHAA) through a circulate notice circulated in what's app to discuss and pass appropriate resolution concerning recent incident reported in Bar and Bench, live law and other media reports with regard to sudden change in roaster which has also been Highlighted by Shri. Asim Pandya, Senior Advocate in his letter dated 15/02/2025 addressed to President GHAA.

While the Meeting was being chaired by President GHAA, objections were raised by members present against the President to chair such meeting and therefore, unanimously Vice-President GHAA was requested to chair such meeting. The members of the Bar were invited to present their views upon the issue and accordingly Shri. Asim Pandya suggested that appropriate representation be made to Hon'ble Chief Justice to recall such decision and displeasure of Bar be shown. Thereafter Shri. Punit Juneja requested to pass appropriate resolution to protect independence of judiciary. Shri. Yatin Oza initially



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opined that such issue can not be discussed in General Body, however at later stage he withdraw such stand and left it to the wisdom of General Body to decide the issue. Thereafter Shri. Bharghav Bhatt, Shri. Dipen Dave and other advocates present put up their views on the issue in question. Finally, Shri. Brijesh Trivedi (President GHCAA) proposed a resolution where in majority of the members of the Bar insisted to insert words "... including seeking transfer of the Hon'ble Chief Justice". Since few members of the Bar had objection to such insertion, the proposal was put to vote and according majority of members voted in favor of such addition. Therefore, following resolution is unanimously passed.

RESOLUTION

1. The House unanimously resolves that the faith of people need to be restored by reversing the recent development, to save the face of judiciary; thereby restoring the sanctity and independence of the judiciary.

2. The House expresses grave concern over the impact of such actions on the reputation of the

3. The House unanimously decides that a representation be made to the Hon'ble Chief Justice of India and other Collegium Judges of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, of recent incident, which has had the effect of lowering the image of the administration of justice.

4. The House further resolves to take appropriate steps, including seeking transfer of the Hon'ble Chief Justice within the framework of law, to ensure that the faith of litigants and the public in the judiciary is restored and that such practices do not recur in the future.

5. It is also resolved to send copy of present resolution to Hon'ble Chief Justice of India.
