O R D E R

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Although diverse reliefs have been claimed, the principal grievance of the petitioner(s) is that the Central Board of Secondary Education (C.B.S.E) may delay the announcement of results of Class-XII Private/Patrachar/2nd chance compartment students. Resultantly, denying the student(s) from taking admission for higher studies.

Learned counsel appearing for the C.B.S.E., on instructions, stated that results of all students including that of Class-XII Private/Patrachar/2nd chance compartment students will be declared before 30.09.2021 as undertaken before this Court on earlier occasion. That position is reiterated and is being so recorded in this order as well.

Learned counsel for the University Grants Commission has pointed out that even if the results are not available and admission process for higher studies commences before 30.09.2021, the petitioner(s) and similarly placed students can apply for admission on provisional basis, subject to producing the results that will be declared by the C.B.S.E. on or before 30.09.2021.

The petitioner(s) had apprehension about such

facility is not being made available by All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) for which reason we had issued notice to AICTE.

Learned counsel appearing for AICTE, on instructions, submits that as in case of other admissions, the petitioner(s) and other similarly placed students will be permitted to take provisional admission, subject to producing the results declared by the C.B.S.E. before 30.09.2021.

In other words, the petitioner(s) can apply to relevant courses for pursuing higher studies on provisional basis and on giving undertaking that the results as declared by C.B.S.E. will be submitted to the concerned college/institution within one week from its issue by the C.B.S.E.

In view of above, nothing more is required to be done in this writ petition. Hence, the same is disposed of.
