This competition will provide the participants with an opportunity for a valuable, educational, and cultural interchange between students, law teachers, and legal practitioners. The 3rd All India Moot Court Competition 2023 shall comprise FIVE rounds: -

- ❖ Memorial Submission — Round 1
- ❖ Video Submission — Round 2
- ❖ Online Quarter Finals — Round 3
- ❖ Offline Semi Finals — Round 4
- ❖ Offline Finals — Round 5

TEAM COMPOSITION AND ELIGIBILITY

- ❖ Each team shall comprise of two speakers and one researcher.
- ❖ Students from all law colleges/institutions/universities across the country recognized by the Bar Council of India are

eligible to take part in the competition.

- ❖ All participants must be currently pursuing their bachelor's degree in Law, i.e., either three-year or five-year courses.
- ❖ Only one team per college shall be allowed to participate.

REGISTRATION PROCEDURE

- ❖ Registration shall be based on a first come first serve basis.
- ❖ Registration procedure shall consist of a provisional registration and a final registration. Provisional registration shall be restricted to a maximum number of 20 teams
- ❖ Each team shall provisionally register by filling out the PROVISIONAL REGISTRATION LINK by 28th January 2023.
- ❖ Teams must fill the Google Form and make the payment only after the confirmation of provisional registration.
- ❖ Provisional registration after the given deadline shall not be accepted, under any circumstances.
- ❖ On completion of provisional registration, organizers shall intimate acknowledgment to the participating teams.
- ❖ The participating teams will have to register themselves through the link released on 4th February 2023(11:59 pm).
- ❖ The team should pay a registration fee of Rs. 3500/- and furnish the details of the same through the final registration form.
- ❖ After final registration each team shall be allotted a unique team code which will be intimated to the Mail ID provided for communication.
