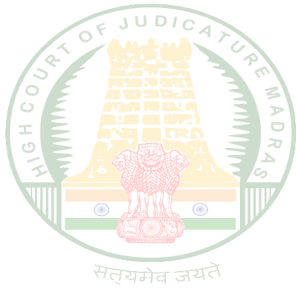

Mr.M.Suresh Kumar, learned counsel representing Mr.D.Ravichandran, learned counsel for the respondents on record submits that in compliance of the order of this Court dated 19.09.2023, the State Government has issued G.O.Ms.No.26, Human Resources Management(G) Department dated 11.06.2025, constituting a Committee to fix time frame to provide compassionate appointment to the legal heirs of the diseased employee and to consider the suggestion for feasibility and to maintain state-wide list of the dependents for compassionate appointments.

2.He placed a copy of the said Government Order before this Court.

3.On perusal of the same, it appears that the Committee is constituted by the State Government by the said Government Order dated 11.06.2025. In fact while allowing W.P. No.2621 of 2020 and etc, batch on 19.09.2023, this Court directed the third respondent therein to constitute a Committee for compassionate appointment and take steps to obtain report from the Committee within two months and the action taken report be placed before this Court within 3 months for consideration.

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4. In view of the above factual position, this Court is of the considered opinion that the order dated 19.09.2023 passed by this Court in W.P. No.2621 of 2020 and etc, batch has not been complied with in true letter and spirit. Only after registering the *suo motu* contempt case against the respondents, the Committee is constituted. It itself shows the attitude of the respondents in implementing the order of this Court.

5. Admit Contempt Case.

6. Issue statutory notice to the respondents for their appearance before this Court.
