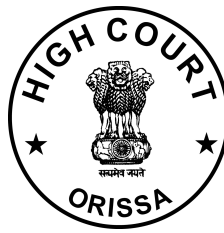

1. It is submitted by Dr. Abhishek Manu Singhvi, learned Senior Advocate appearing for the petitioners that the instant matter not only involves the issues which are identical to the other matters, but a disparity on factual matrix can also be seen as the authority in the garb of the alleged demand is contemplating to reject the trading license.



2. This matter is taken up for final disposal and Mr. Singhvi, learned Senior Advocate has made a substantial argument in this regard and prayed for an interim protection apprehending coercive steps that may be taken against the petitioners pending the instant writ petition.

3. In other connected matters involving the similar and identical issues, this Court has passed interim order. We do not find any justification in treating the petitioners on a different pedestal than that of the other petitioners. We, therefore, restrain the opposite parties-authorities from taking any coercive step against the petitioners till the next date of hearing.

4. On the consent of the learned counsels appearing for the parties, let this matter be listed along with the connected matters on 3rd December, 2025.
