Learned counsel for petitioner submits that in the said Primary Health Center at Rajnagar, Distirct Anuppur, there is only one doctor who sits only twice a week and that also one hour on the said day. There are over 50,000 tribals and rural residents who are dependent on the said center but there is insufficient medical facility available in the center. He further submits that even the access road to the center is in a condition that it is virtually impossible for people to travel on the same.

Learned counsel for respondent prays for time to take instructions in respect of road condition and submit report.

At request, re-notify on 10.07.2025.

In the meantime, respondent authority shall ensure that the Primary Health Center has the requisite number of doctors and paramedical available to cater to the tribals and rural residents who are dependents on the said center.
