SYNOPSIS

- The Petitioners are MBBS graduate doctors who have appeared for the NEET – PG 2024 and have participated in the ongoing counselling process for NEET-PG 2024. The main grievance of the Petitioners is that the seat remaining vacant after round 3 were not open to all the NEET PG 2024 qualified candidates who possess the degree of MBBS from anywhere (recognized by NMC) (hereinafter “**All India Candidates**”) in the third round of State Allotment Process.
- That the Petitioners are meritorious candidates who would have otherwise gotten a seat which was vacant after round 3 of State counselling. However, they are either not getting a seat or getting the same seat at an exorbitant cost and the difference in the fee is over approximately Rs. 30 Lacks for each academic session, i.e., Rs. 90 Lacks for the complete course.
- That the Petitioners are also aggrieved because since the vacant state seats will now directly go to the stray round, wherein they are ineligible to participate, the said seats will be allotted to the candidates with much lower rank, which creates a window of disparity.
- That the act of Respondents is in sheer disregard to the fundamental rights of the candidates under Article 14, 19 and 21. It is trite that no other state except for Rajasthan has incorporated the Impugned Clause in the Instruction Booklet.
- That the Petitioners will severely be affected since they will be forced to continue to stick with the same branch for rest of their lives and will never have an option to opt for the seat is going vacant directly to the stray round.
- That after getting to knowledge of the seat matrix and the vacant seats, the Petitioners immediately reached out to the Respondents through phone calls and email. However, they were orally informed that the vacant state seats will not be provided to them and will directly be part

of the stray round of counselling. Aggrieved by the said action, the Petitioners have no other option but to file the present writ petition.

MAY IT PLEASE YOUR LORDSHIP,

The humble petitioner most respectfully begs to submit as
under:

1. That the petitioners are citizen of India and entitled to invoke the extraordinary jurisdiction of this Hon'ble High Court in the Article 226 Constitution of India. All the petitioners having common grievances, and their prayer is also common, therefore, as such they are filing this joint writ petition before the Hon'ble High Court and bar contained under Rule 375 (4) of High Court Rules may not be applied in the present case.
2. That, by way of said writ petition, petitioners challenge the illegal action of the respondents by which respondents issued the instruction booklet in which the clause 2-(ii) stipulates that any seat remaining vacant after round 3 shall be filled in stray vacancy round without applying the state eligibility criteria and are not open to the all NEET PG 2024 qualified candidates who possess the degree of MBBS from

anywhere (recognized by NMC) (hereinafter “**All India Candidates**”) in the third round of State Allotment Process. The relevant portion of the instruction booklet is extracted hereinunder for the ready reference of this Hon’ble High Court:

*“**Note:** State eligibility criteria, as mentioned in clause (i) for state quota seats shall be applicable upto round 3 allotment process. Any seat remaining vacant after round 3 shall be filled in stray vacancy round without applying the state eligibility criteria.”*

3. That, the fact arising out of the present Writ Petition are as follows:
 - a. The Respondent No.1 issued 2023 Instruction booklet for State PG State Medical PG seats (M.D./M.S.) / Post MBBS DNB / Post MBBS Diploma on 29.07.2023

A true copy of the 2023 Instruction booklet for State PG State Medical PG seats (M.D./M.S.) / Post MBBS DNB / Post MBBS Diploma is annexed herewith and marked as “Annexure P – 1” (Page).
 - b. The Respondent No.1 issued 2024 Instruction booklet for State PG State Medical PG seats (M.D./M.S.) / Post MBBS DNB / Post MBBS Diploma on 17.11.2024

A true copy of the 2024 Instruction booklet for State PG State Medical PG seats (M.D./M.S.) / Post MBBS DNB / Post MBBS Diploma is annexed herewith and marked as “Annexure P – 2” (Page).

- c. The Petitioners appeared in the NEET PG 2024 exam on 11.08.2024.
- d. The results for NEET-PG 2024 were declared on 23.08.2024.
- e. The Rajasthan State Round 1 counselling commenced from 17.11.2024.
- f. The Rajasthan State Round 2 counselling commenced from 22.12.2024.
- g. The Rajasthan State Round 3 counselling commenced from 18.01.2025.
- h. That the seat matrix for Round 3 was released on 03.02.2025
A true copy of the seat matrix for Round 3 is annexed herewith and marked as “Annexure P – 3” (Page).
- i. That the results for Round 3 State counselling were declared on 10.02.2025.
A copy of the Allotment letters issued to the Petitioners is annexed herewith and marked as “Annexure P – 4 COLLY” (Page).
- j. That the candidates were shocked to know that several State Quota seats were left vacant which otherwise would have been allotted to them if the state seats would have been provided to All India Quota. A tabular chart representing the same is provided hereunder for the ready reference of this Hon’ble Court:

k. That after getting to knowledge of the seat matrix and the vacant seats, the Petitioners immediately reached out to the Respondents through phone calls and email. However, they were orally informed that the vacant state seats will not be provided to them and will directly be part of the stray round of counselling. Aggrieved by the said action, the Petitioners have no other option but to file the present writ petition.

A true copy of the email dated 12.02.2025 issued by Petitioner No. 1 is annexed herewith and marked as “Annexure P – 5” (Page).

l. Hence, the Petitioners being aggrieved were forced to approach this Hon’ble Court and have filed the present Writ Petition on the following grounds amongst others:-

GROUND

- A. Because, the act of depriving the candidates with the seat for which they are otherwise eligible is violative of their fundamental right guaranteed under Article 14 and 21 of the Constitution of India.
- B. Because, the act of not providing the vacant State seats to the candidates belonging to the All-India Quota creates an artificial divide which discriminates and is a disadvantage to these meritorious students.
- C. Because, the act of Respondents in sending the vacant State Quota seats directly to stray round before providing the same to the AIQ candidates which in turn is preventing the AIQ students to choose those vacant seats which is arbitrary, unjust and in clear violation of the fundamental rights of the Petitioners.
- D. Because, the left over State Quota seats were always provided to the AIQ candidates in previous years as also stated in the 2023 Instruction booklet for State PG State Medical PG seats (M.D./M.S.) / Post MBBS DNB / Post MBBS Diploma which is stated below:

“Provided that in case during/after third round of counseling, adequate number of candidates having eligibility as mentioned in clause (i) are not available for admission, then all NEET Qualified candidates who possess the degree of MBBS from anywhere (Recognized by NMC) will be considered as per merit on the seats remaining vacant after exhaustion of the list of candidates having eligibility as per clause (i).”

Whereas, the 2024 Instructions booklet for State PG State Medical PG seats (M.D./M.S.) / Post MBBS DNB / Post MBBS Diploma states that:

“Note: State eligibility criteria, as mentioned in clause (i) for state quota seats shall be applicable upto round 3 allotment process. Any seat remaining vacant after round 3 shall be filled in stray vacancy round without applying the state eligibility criteria.”

- E. Because, as the vacant seats of the State Quota will go to stray round but the candidates who could have got a better seat if the State Quota seats would have been provided to AIQ, will now be forced to take the same seats in Management quota despite having a better rank.
- F. Because, as the vacant seats of the State Quota will go to stray round but the candidates who could have got these seats if the State Quota seats would have been provided to AIQ, will now be allotted to the lower rankers in stray round and these candidates will be forced to take the same seats in Management quota despite having a better rank.
- G. Because, the act of Respondents of not converting the vacant State Quota seats into AIQ seats in Round 3 of counselling and directly converting them into AIQ in stray round is against the principles of natural justice and the general practice of counselling which has been practiced from long time in all the states.
- H. Because, due to such act, the Petitioners are forced to take up a seat in management quota by paying a hefty amount in fees despite there being vacant seats in the end of third round of counselling.

- I. Because, the act of Respondents in not letting the Petitioners to appear and participate in stray round which is a sheer violation of their fundamental rights as they even after having a better rank are being forced to settle with lower ranked seats and the students with lower ranks will get a better seat in the stray rounds.
- J. Because the Petitioners are victim of circumstances since without any fault on their part they lost the seats which they were otherwise eligible for.
- K. Because, the change in the instruction booklet is depriving the candidates with the seat for which they were otherwise eligible.
- L. Because, the change in the instruction booklet has not been clarified by the Rajasthan State PG Counselling Board 2024 which is arbitrary, unjust and violative of the fundamental rights of the Petitioners.
- M. Because other grounds will be urged at the time of arguments.
- N. That the Petitioner has been left with no other alternative, efficacious and speedy remedy except to approach this Hon'ble Court by filing the present writ petition under Article 226 of the constitution of India.
- O. That the Petitioner has not filed any such other writ petition either before this Hon'ble Court or before Hon'ble the Supreme Court of India.

PRAYER

It is therefore, humble prayed that this writ petition may kindly be accepted and allow and call for and examine entire record of the case and;

- a) The Hon'ble Court may kindly be pleased to set aside the result for State Round III counselling and convert the vacant state seats into

All India quota and allow the fresh result to be released basis the above allotment;

- b) In an alternative, the Hon'ble Court may kindly be pleased to conduct an additional round for the vacant state seats and allow the Petitioners to participate in the additional round of counselling;
- c) In an alternative, the Hon'ble Court may kindly be pleased to permit the Petitioners to participate in the stray round of State counselling;
- d) Any other order or direction which this Hon'ble court deems just and proper may also be passed in favour of the petitioner.

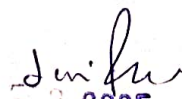

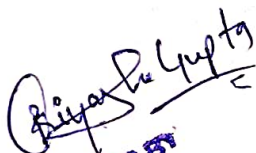

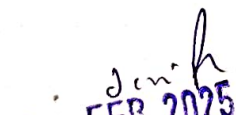

Application Fee

All candidates are required to deposit non-refundable application fee of Rs. 3000/- (Rs. 1500/- for SC, ST category candidate of Rajasthan state domicile) + applicable transaction charges.

All eligible candidates who wish to participate in the counseling process must register themselves through the above mentioned websites by completing Part 1 as well as Part 2 of application form.

A candidate who fails to register by completing both Part 1 as well as Part 2 of application form, shall not be eligible to participate in the further process of counseling.

For verification, candidate belonging to PwD / Senior Demonstrator category **must present personally along with relevant original documents** and one set of photocopy of the same, at given place and time.

During the process, the eligibility criteria, relevant documents, etc. of the candidates shall primarily be checked. After checking, Medical College/Institute and subject shall be allotted to the candidate according to the merit, the choice(s) filled by the candidate and availability of the seats as per the norms and in accordance with the rules and the directions laid down by Hon'ble Supreme Court of India/Hon'ble Rajasthan High Court/MCI/NMC/NBE/Government of Rajasthan, but the admission will be subject to verification of his/her documents for which the decision of the Principal of the concerned allotted college or the Board shall be final.

Only NEET PG 2023 qualified and registered with Rajasthan State PG Counseling Board 2023 candidates shall be eligible for admission.

2. State Eligibility

Degree seats (MD/MS)

- (i) For 50% of the total seats in Government colleges as well as 50% of the total seats in Private Colleges, the NEET qualified candidates who possess the degree of MBBS from the colleges situated in the State of Rajasthan and all medical officers/medical teachers serving under Government of Rajasthan are eligible to participate, but on 25% seats out of these seats in Govt. colleges, preference shall be given to the candidates who possess the degree of MBBS awarded by the University of Rajasthan / Rajasthan University of Health Sciences; and
- (ii) for the remaining 50% of the total seats of Private Colleges, all NEET Qualified candidates who possess the degree of MBBS from anywhere (Recognized by NMC) are eligible to participate;

Provided that in case during/after third round of counseling, adequate number of candidates having eligibility as mentioned in clause (i) are not available for admission, then all NEET Qualified candidates who possess the degree of MBBS from anywhere (Recognized by NMC) will be considered as per merit on the seats remaining vacant after exhaustion of the list of candidates having eligibility as per clause (i).

Provisions for Senior Demonstrators: As per Government order dated 31.03.2017 and 05.04.2017, regularly selected Senior Demonstrator working in Non-Clinical & Para Clinical Departments of Medical colleges run by Government, Government Societies and Government Universities will be given priority (in the same department in which they are working) in Non-Clinical & Para-Clinical PG Degree seats allotment. They will be considered only after completing three years of regular service in the same department and qualifying the NEET examination. NOC (specifying service duration also) of the employer will also be necessary.

Post MBBS Diploma and Post MBBS DNB seats

50% seats of the total sanctioned seats will be filled by State Counseling Board. All these seats are reserved for in-service candidates serving under Government of Rajasthan.

3. Eligibility (Academic)

Applicable to all categories

The candidate should have

- Obtained MBBS qualification recognized by MCI/NMC
- Completed satisfactorily one year's compulsory rotatory internship (**as on 11.08.2023**, as per NBE order dated 07.02.2023 after passing the final MBBS examination. No condonation of compulsory rotatory internship shall be accepted.
- Possessing registration from MCI/NMC/Rajasthan/other state Medical Council (provisional or permanent). The candidates registered with council other than Rajasthan medical council are required to submit RMC certificate within one month after joining, at the allotted college.
- Secured minimum of marks at 50th percentile (40th percentile in case of natural born SC, ST, OBC, MBC (most backward classes) and 45th percentile in case of locomotor disabled for unreserved candidates) in the NEET PG 2023.

In-service category

- Weightage of Bonus Marks in the obtained NEET PG 2023 score shall be given to all eligible in-service candidates after verification by Directorate of Medical and Health Department, Rajasthan.
- Other criteria / conditions shall be as per the Government of Rajasthan norms i.e. service conditions, age etc.

Note: Candidates must ensure that they have scored minimum percentile in NEET PG 2023 before addition of bonus marks to be eligible for application form filling and registration for State Counseling.

4. Reservation

All admissions to MD/MS courses shall be given as per reservation roster. Whatever the seats in whichever Medical colleges are available as per merit will be allotted to the candidates as per Reservation Roster and as per their choice. At roster point of UR all candidates will be considered as per their merit but at roster point of SC, ST, STA, OBC-NCL, MBC-NCL, EWS, the concerned category candidates will be considered as per their merit.

Treatment to be given to the candidates belonging to the SC/ST/BC who are selected against unreserved category vacancies on the basis of their merit shall be as per circular no. F.7(1)DOP/A-II/99 Dated 26-07-2017 issued by the Department of Personnel, Rajasthan.

Note: As per letter no. F7(111)/DME/PG/2020/Part/1345, dated 17.03.2020 of Directorate of Medical Education and UO Note no. F7(1)/DOP/A-2/19 dated 22.02.2019 of DOP (A-2) Department, the EWS reservation shall be applicable on all educational institutions.

Not less than 25% seats out of each category of SC, ST, STA, OBC-NCL, MBC-NCL, EWS and unreserved category shall be filled from female candidates.

The norms of reservation of the State Government of Rajasthan will be applicable only for bonafide candidates of the State of Rajasthan. SC / ST / OBC NCL / MBC NCL/EWS candidates of state other than Rajasthan state shall be considered as unreserved category candidates. All candidates of reserved category shall submit valid caste / EWS certificate as per State Government rules.

Note: OBC NCL / MBC NCL candidate must submit **valid OBC NCL / MBC NCL Certificate** (clearly indicating 'Non Creamy Layer') for Rajasthan State by competent authority of Rajasthan. Refer the direction letter no. 54159, dated 09.09.2015 issued by Social Justice and Empowerment Department, Govt. of Rajasthan, Jaipur.

EWS candidate must submit EWS Certificate (Valid for Financial year 2023-24) for Rajasthan State issued by competent authority of Rajasthan.

PwD reservation

5% seats shall be reserved horizontally for candidates with specified disabilities (PwD) under the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 and in accordance with the provisions of the "Postgraduate Medical Education Regulations, 2000". It is clarified that PwD candidates shall only be considered on the roster point reserved for PwD as per his/her PwD merit.

The "Certificate of Disability" issued in accordance with the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Rules, 2017 and as per norms of Regulating Authority. The disability certificate issued by 16 centers approved by MCC shall only be considered. **List of approved centers and proforma of certificate of disability are attached as Schedule - 1.**

Note: The PwD candidates must ensure that they possess the disability certificate issued for NEET PG admissions 2023, by 16 centers approved by MCC. Refer order no. U-12021/02/2023-MEC, dated 27.06.2023 issued by MCC.

Unfilled reserved seat(s)

During/after the third round of counseling the unfilled reserved seat(s) of any category shall be treated un-reserved and shall be filled accordingly.

5. Seat matrix

The seat matrix will be published in due course. Responsibility of type of seats in the seat matrix shall lie with the concerned institution and not with the Counseling Board.

6. Fee Details

Fee details as provided by the concerned institute will be published in due course. Responsibility of type of seats and Fee levied on such seats shall lie with the concerned institution and not with the State Counseling Board.

Refer order dated 19.05.2022 of Hon'ble Supreme Court in civil appeal no. 3978-3995/2017.

7. Application / Registration procedure

Before proceeding, read the instructions booklet, notification and other information etc. very carefully.

You should be very careful in filling-up the on-line application form. If any lapse is detected during the scrutiny, your candidature may be rejected even if you come through the final stage of admission process or even at a later stage.

IMPORTANT: HANDWRITTEN / TYPED / PHOTOSTAT COPIES / PRINTED APPLICATION FORM/ SCREEN PRINTOUT WILL NOT BE ENTERTAINED.

You should make sure of your eligibility etc. and that the declaration made by you regarding your eligibility is correct in all respects. You will be liable to legal action and / or punishment as may be deemed fit by the Admission Board in case it is found that you have furnished in-correct information or made false declaration regarding your eligibility at any stage or suppressed any information.

The jurisdiction for legal cases arising out of PG Medical Admissions/Allotments 2023 shall be limited to the Rajasthan High Court only.

The decision of the Admission Board in all aspects pertaining to the application and its acceptance or rejection as the case may be, conduct of counseling and at all consequent stages culminating in the admission or otherwise of any candidate shall be final and binding on all concerned.

The admission board reserves its right to alter and modify time schedule and conditions laid down in the notification, instruction booklet for conducting the various stages up to the admission, duly intimating details thereof on the website, as warranted by any unforeseen circumstances arising during the course of this process, or as deemed necessary by the admission board at any stage.

Ensure that you follow the steps as given in Part B of this booklet.

“Note your password for further steps. Keep it safe.”

The NEET PG Counseling Board 2023 will not be responsible for any consequences arising out of forgotten password / misuse of your password. It is your responsibility to maintain confidentiality of your password. Sharing of your password can result in its misuse by somebody else, leading to even exclusion of a genuine candidate from the on-line allotment process.

8. Choice filling

The guidelines and requirements for choice filling will be available with publication of seat matrix. Candidates must fill their choices, very carefully, based on the seat matrix and corresponding fee structure.

Any candidate opting seats permitted by the MCI/NMC will not be allowed to claim for any change on this ground, except during subsequent allotment depending upon his/her merit and as per preference only.

If a candidate does not submit his/her choice till the specified date and time, he/she will lose chance of participation in the on-line allotment process. The choices are required to be filled **very carefully** as the choices filled shall be final for on-line allotments for that round only.

It is mandatory to fill fresh choices in each and every round irrespective of whether the candidate was allotted/joined a seat in previous round or not (subject to the candidate is eligible to participate and willing to participate/upgrade in subsequent round). The choices filled by a candidate in previous round shall be scraped and will not be considered for further rounds.

Note: If a candidate does not fill fresh choices for subsequent round(s) then he/she will not be considered for allotment / upgradation.

9. Allotments

The allotment of the subject and college / institute shall be made strictly on the basis of merit cum preference as per the reservation roster and in accordance with the rules laid down by Hon'ble Supreme Court of India/Hon'ble Rajasthan High Court/MCI/NMC/NBE/ Government of Rajasthan.

10. Inter-se merit

Merit list shall be prepared on the basis of marks obtained in NEET PG 2023 after adding bonus marks if any as notified by the State Government according to the rules and regulations of the concerned Regulating Authority. The inter-se merit of the candidates securing equal marks will be in the following order:

- (a) One who has higher rank in NEET PG 2023
- (b) The candidate of higher age (older candidate).
- (c) One who has passed final MBBS in lesser number of attempts.
- (d) One who has secured more marks (aggregate) in final year MBBS.

11. Security amount

Before choice filling stage, candidates participating will have to pay refundable security amount as under:

Rs. 25,000/- for UR/EWS candidates or **Rs. 12,500/-** for SC/ST/ST-STA/OBC/MBC candidates opting for MD/MS course in Government Medical Colleges, Govt. Society Medical Colleges, RUHS CMS

Rs. 2,00,000/- for candidate opting for MD/MS course in Private Medical colleges

[Candidates depositing Rs. 2,00,000/- will automatically be eligible to fill choices for Government Medical Colleges, Govt. Society Medical Colleges, RUHS CMS]

The Security Deposit will be forfeited if a candidate who has been allotted a seat in the Second Round or subsequent rounds and does not join the respective institution. Also, the Security Deposit will be forfeited if the admission gets cancelled due to any reason e.g in case the candidate gives wrong information at the time of registration (application form filling) on the basis of which a seat may be allotted and later cancelled by the Board or fails to produce the required essential documents at the time of joining (within stipulated time).

1. The security amount if not forfeited, will be refunded after completion of counseling process, to the concerned bank account from which the security amount is deposited.
2. A candidate allotted a seat in First Round and does not join the allotted college will be eligible for subsequent round without forfeiture of security amount.
3. First round joined candidate who has not been up-graded during second round counseling or has not participated in second round may resign without forfeiture of security amount within two days of declaration of round 2 result, failing which he will be considered as joined candidate for second round and rules will apply accordingly.

4. A candidate allotted a seat (fresh / upgraded) in second round of counseling and does not join the allotted seat or resigns, his/her security amount will be forfeited. Such candidate shall be eligible to participate in further rounds on fresh application and on depositing security amount again.
5. A candidate having joined status on completion of second round and willing to participate for upgradation in third round will be eligible only on fresh application and on depositing security amount again.
6. A candidate allotted a seat (fresh / upgraded) in third round of counseling and does not join the allotted seat, his/her security amount will be forfeited. Such candidate shall not be eligible to participate in further round.
7. A candidate allotted a seat in stray vacancy round does not join the allotted seat **shall be debarred from participating in the State counseling process for next one year**, alongwith forfeiture of security amount.
8. No candidate will be allowed to resign from the State Quota seats after joining in round 3 or in subsequent round.

Note:

No candidate can join two colleges/institutes at the same time. At the time of round 3 of the allotment process, such candidates who have registered for the state counseling and who have joined other college/institute (as on a specified date) through round 3 All India counseling or any other counseling and hence as per the directions of Hon'ble Supreme Court shall be in-eligible for allotment in State round 3 and subsequent round.

The Registration amount will be forfeited in case the candidate gives wrong information at the time of application on the basis of which a seat may be allotted and later cancelled by the Admission Authorities at the time of joining.

12. Joining at the allotted college

Round 1

The candidates admitted to all medical colleges will have to deposit one year tuition fees only through Demand draft payable to the allotted college / receipt of the electronic (on-line) mode paid to the allotted college at the time of joining in Round 1 counseling, to the allotted college along with original documents and requisite bond. (please refer to respective college website).

Round 2

The candidates admitted to all medical colleges will have to deposit one year tuition fees only through Demand draft payable to the allotted college / receipt of the electronic (on-line) mode paid to the allotted college at the time of joining in Round 2 counseling, to the allotted college along with original documents and requisite bond. (please refer to respective college website).

Note: Original documents of the upgraded candidates shall be transferred directly to the upgraded college and will not be handed over to the candidate.

Round 3

The candidates admitted to all medical colleges will have to deposit one year tuition fees only through Demand draft payable to the allotted college / receipt of the electronic (on-line) mode paid to the allotted college at the time of joining in Round 3 counseling, to the allotted college along with original documents and requisite bond. (please refer to respective college website).

The candidates who retain round 1 / round 2 allotted seat in round 3 of counseling will have to submit other fees/ charges and complete other formalities as per guidelines given in the respective college website by the last date of joining of third counseling.

Each candidate shall join the allotted college and course within the time as mentioned in the allotment letter issued on-line. There is no provision of extension for joining date. The allotment made will be firm and final. Change of college/course from one place to another is not permitted. Therefore, request for the same would not be entertained by the Admission Board after the allotment.

The selected candidates should bring all the requisite documents in original and also submit an undertaking in **Proforma-1** that the submitted documents are in original along with one set of self-attested copies of documents, at the time of joining at the allotted college, failing which their admission shall stand cancelled. These original documents may be kept with the institution till completion of the course.

The fact that a candidate has appeared for allotment shall not entitle him/her for allotment reallocation as the same will be subject to availability of seat and acceptance of the available seats at the rank of the candidate by him/her.

The academic session will commence as per NMC notification, from **05.09.2023**.

The selection for this admission shall be cancelled if the selected candidates do not join at the allotted college and deposit fees upto the stipulated date or whose particulars are found to be incorrect.

The candidates must present the accepted resignation/relieving letter from the institution he/ she is pursuing studies at present, at the time of joining. Failure to do so will result in disqualification for admission.

The selected candidates must also carry all requisite certificates and documents in original and also submit an undertaking that the submitted documents are in original along with self-attested copies of the same, at the time of joining and shall deposit the applicable fees of the allotted college and complete other formalities within stipulated time, failing which their admission shall stand cancelled. These original documents may be kept with the institution till completion of the course.

A candidate without original certificates / documents shall not be allowed to take admission at the allotted college under any circumstances. A candidate who has already been admitted in PG course and has deposited his / her certificates in any medical college/ institute / university and participate for counseling (allotment process) with a certificate stating that "his/her original certificates are deposited with the medical college/ institute / university" (except the college allotted through NEET-PG counseling

2023 of Rajasthan state process), will NOT be allowed to take admission at the allotted college.

The colleges shall be provided the list of candidates allotted. The colleges shall verify the credentials of reporting candidates as per this list and check the documents and other required certificates with originals.

The admissions shall be treated as provisional subject to the final decision of any pending case(s) in any court of law, if applicable to these admissions. Further, the provisional status of admission shall stand cleared only after enrolment by the concerned University.

The non-viewing of the websites about allotment information by the candidate shall not be accepted as a ground for non-joining by the scheduled time and date. The candidate's allotment will stand automatically cancelled if he/she does not join IN PERSON at the allotted college as per the notified schedule.

The candidate shall also submit an undertaking (on non-judicial stamp of Rs. 50/ duly notarized) that (a) all documents produced by him/her are in original or (b) in case original documents are lost, stolen or destroyed, the duplicate copy of the documents so submitted are duly issued by the competent authority and (c) if any facts are found false he/she shall be liable for cancellation of his/her admission as well as legal action as may be deemed proper by the State Admission Board / State Government (**Proforma 1**, available in the instruction booklet).

13. Conditions relating to bond etc. (applicable for Govt. medical colleges/RajMes Medical Colleges/RUHS CMS/Government District Hospitals)

Surety Bond

At the time of allotment, the selected candidates (both All India and State quota) will have to submit a surety bond of Rs. 5.00 lacs (Rupees five lacs) toward 'not to leave the course in between' (proforma available at the website).

At the time of final joining, a separate Bank Guarantee for Rs. 1.5 lacs and Bond for Rs. 3.5 lacs is to be submitted (surety bond of Rs. 5 lacs submitted earlier will be returned).

Service Bond

The students so selected (for the academic session 2023-24) (except students who are in service of ESI or Central Government or Rajasthan Government or other state Government and already filled service Bond for this purpose) will have to fill a bond amounting to Rs. 25 lacs (Rupees twenty five lacs) for commitment to serve the State Government of Rajasthan for a period of two (2) years (in the applicable bond format) (Refer copy of order no. P7(86)CM/HM/Budget/DME/Acad/2015/8000, dated 12.07.2022 issued by the Government of Rajasthan).

It is clarified that a candidate, who on the date of allotment is in the government service, joins the course after resigning / leaving that service, shall have to fill the above service bond.

At the time of joining, all the original certificates of the candidate shall be deposited in the concerned allotted college towards execution of the bonds. The concerned allotted college shall have the right to retain all the original certificates of the students till compliance of the conditions of the bonds.

14. Conditions relating bond/bank guarantee* and other formalities (applicable for private colleges)

At the time of joining (on completion of round 3), all the joined candidates of round 1, round 2 as well as round 3 will have to submit a bond / bank guarantee* (if applicable). For details, refer website of respective private colleges / contact college office.

* Refer the judgment dated 31.05.2021 of Hon'ble Rajasthan High Court at Jodhpur in DBCWP No. 13535/2020 Deepesh Singh Beniwal Vs Union of India & Ors. The matter is sub-judice before the Hon'ble Supreme Court in SLP (C) No. 11296/2021.

Important: Documents checking and verification

The PG Admission/Counseling Board processes the allotments of college and course to the candidates based on the information filled/provided by the candidates in the on-line application/registration form. Documents checking and verification (including prescribed eligibility criteria) is subsequently done only at the level of the college allotted to the candidate, at the time of joining, during the entire admission process and is responsibility of the concerned college.

Candidate should be very careful in filling-up the on-line application form and must ensure fulfillment of the eligibility criteria etc. at the level of concerned College/University. If at any stage a candidate is found non-eligible for admission to the allotted course, his/her candidature is subject to rejection even if he/she comes through the final stage of admission process or even at a later stage.

A candidates will be deemed to have joined an institution once his/her original documents are submitted, reported physically at the allotted institution and have deposited the requisite fee.

The Chairman, NEET PG Admission/Counseling Board - 2024, Jaipur would conduct the centralized common counseling for the session 2024-25, for admission to PG Medical (M.D./ M.S.), Post MBBS DNB, and Post MBBS Diploma Courses, for all the 4 rounds of counselling i.e. Round 1, Round 2, Round 3 and Stray Vacancy Round, in State of Rajasthan.

Online Counselling

There shall be 4 (four) rounds of allotment process. All 4 rounds of allotment including Stray vacancy round shall be conducted on-line. No round shall be conducted off-line. No admission shall be made at college level.

Application

Online applications for registration - invited from eligible NEET PG 2024 qualified candidates from 25.09.2024 to 02.11.2024 and 17.11.2024 to 18.11.2024.

All candidates are required to deposit non-refundable application fee of Rs. 4000/- (Rs. 3000/- for SC, ST category candidate of Rajasthan state domicile) + applicable transaction charges.

All eligible candidates who wish to participate in the counseling process must register themselves through the above mentioned websites by completing Part 1 as well as Part 2 of application form.

2. State Eligibility

Degree seats (MD/MS)

- (i) For 50% of the total seats in Government colleges as well as 50% of the total seats in Private Colleges, the NEET PG 2024 qualified candidates who possess the degree of MBBS from the colleges situated in the State of Rajasthan and all medical officers/medical teachers serving under Government of Rajasthan are eligible to participate, but on 25% seats out of these seats in Govt. colleges, preference shall be given to the candidates who possess the degree of MBBS awarded by the University of Rajasthan / Rajasthan University of Health Sciences; and
- (ii) for the remaining 50% of the total seats of Private Colleges, all NEET PG 2024 Qualified candidates who possess the degree of MBBS from anywhere (Recognized by NMC) are eligible to participate;

Note: State eligibility criteria, as mentioned in clause (i) for state quota seats shall be applicable upto round 3 allotment process. Any seat remaining vacant after round 3 shall be filled in stray vacancy round without applying the state eligibility criteria.

Provisions for Senior Demonstrators: As per Government order dated 31.03.2017 and 05.04.2017, regularly selected Senior Demonstrator working in their respective Departments of Medical colleges run by Government, Government Societies and Government Universities will be given priority (in the same department in which they are working) in respective PG Degree seats allotment. They will be considered only after completing three years of regular service in the same department and qualifying the NEET examination. NOC (specifying service duration also) of the employer will also be necessary.

Post MBBS Diploma and Post MBBS DNB seats

50% seats of the total sanctioned seats will be filled by State Counseling Board. All these seats are reserved for in-service candidates serving under Government of Rajasthan.

3. Eligibility (Academic)

Applicable to all categories

The candidate should have

- Obtained MBBS qualification recognized by MCI/NMC
- Completed satisfactorily one year's compulsory rotatory internship (**as on 15.08.2024**, as per NMC public notice dated 20.03.2024 after passing the final MBBS examination. No condonation of compulsory rotatory internship shall be accepted.

- Possessing registration from MCI/NMC/Rajasthan/other state Medical Council (provisional or permanent). The candidates registered with council other than Rajasthan medical council are required to submit RMC certificate within one month after joining, at the allotted college.
- Secured minimum of marks at 50th percentile (40th percentile in case of natural born SC, ST, OBC, MBC (most backward classes) and 45th percentile in case of locomotor disabled for unreserved candidates) in the NEET PG 2024.

In-service category

- Weightage of Bonus Marks in the obtained NEET PG 2024 score shall be given to all eligible in-service candidates after verification by Directorate of Medical and Health Department, Rajasthan.
- Other criteria / conditions shall be as per the Government of Rajasthan norms i.e. service conditions, age etc.

Note: Candidates must ensure that they have scored minimum percentile in NEET PG 2024 before addition of bonus marks to be eligible for application form filling and registration for State Counseling.

4. Reservation

All admissions to MD/MS courses shall be given as per reservation roster. Whatever the seats in whichever Medical colleges are available as per merit will be allotted to the candidates as per Reservation Roster and as per their choice. At roster point of OC all candidates will be considered as per their merit but at roster point of SC, ST, STA, OBC-NCL, MBC-NCL, EWS, the concerned category candidates will be considered as per their merit.

Treatment to be given to the candidates belonging to the SC/ST/BC who are selected against unreserved category vacancies on the basis of their merit shall be as per circular no. F.7(1)DOP/A-II/99 Dated 26-07-2017 issued by the Department of Personnel, Rajasthan.

Note: As per letter no. F7(111)/DME/PG/2020/Part/1345, dated 17.03.2020 of Directorate of Medical Education and UO Note no. F7(1)/DOP/A-2/19 dated 22.02.2019 of DOP (A-2) Department, the EWS reservation shall be applicable on all educational institutions.

Not less than 25% seats out of each category of SC, ST, STA, OBC-NCL, MBC-NCL, EWS and unreserved category shall be filled from female candidates.

The norms of reservation of the State Government of Rajasthan will be applicable only for bonafide candidates of the State of Rajasthan. SC / ST / OBC NCL / MBC NCL/EWS candidates of state other than Rajasthan state shall be considered as unreserved category candidates. All candidates of reserved category for State of Rajasthan shall submit **valid** caste / EWS certificate as per State Government rules.

Note: OBC NCL / MBC NCL candidate must submit **valid OBC NCL / MBC NCL Certificate** (clearly indicating 'Non Creamy Layer') for Rajasthan State by competent authority of Rajasthan. Refer the direction letter no. 54159, dated 09.09.2015 issued by Social Justice and Empowerment Department, Govt. of Rajasthan, Jaipur.

EWS candidate must submit EWS Certificate (Valid for Financial year 2024-25) for Rajasthan State issued by competent authority of Rajasthan.

PwD reservation

5% seats shall be reserved horizontally for candidates with specified disabilities (PwD) under the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 and in accordance with the provisions of the "Postgraduate Medical Education Regulations" of NMC. It is clarified that PwD candidates shall only be considered on the roster point reserved for PwD as per his/her PwD merit.

The "Certificate of Disability" issued in accordance with the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Rules, 2017 and as per norms of Regulating Authority. The disability certificate issued by 16 centers approved by MCC shall only be considered. **List of approved centers is attached as Schedule - 1.**

Note: The PwD candidates must ensure that they possess the disability certificate issued for NEET PG admissions 2024, by 16 centers approved by MCC. Refer order no. U-12021/03/2024-MEC, dated 21.06.2024 issued by MCC.

Unfilled reserved seat(s)

During / after the round 3 of counselling and on exhaustion of the list of reserved category candidates, the roster point earmarked for that category shall be treated un-reserved and shall be filled accordingly.

5. Seat matrix

The seat matrix will be published in due course at the website (www.rajpgneet2024.org).

Responsibility of type of seats in the seat matrix shall lie with the concerned institution and not with the Counseling Board. Updated Vacant seat matrix will also be made available on our website before the start of each round of counselling.

8. Choice filling

The guidelines and requirements for choice filling will be available with publication of seat matrix. Candidates must fill their choices, very carefully, based on the seat matrix and corresponding fee structure.

If a candidate does not submit his/her choice till the specified date and time, he/she will lose chance of participation in the on-line allotment process. The choices are required to be filled **very carefully** as the choices filled shall be final for on-line allotments for that round only.

It is mandatory to fill fresh choices in each and every round irrespective of whether the candidate was allotted/joined a seat in previous round or not (subject to the candidate is eligible to participate and willing to participate/upgrade in subsequent round). 9. Allotments

The allotment of the subject and college / institute shall be made strictly on the basis of merit cum preference as per the reservation roster and in accordance with the rules laid down by Hon'ble Supreme Court of India/Hon'ble Rajasthan High Court/MCI/NMC/NBE/ Government of Rajasthan.

10. Inter-se merit

For round 1 of counselling, Merit list shall be prepared by NBE on the basis of marks obtained in NEET PG 2024 after adding bonus marks (for in-service candidates), if any, as notified by the State Government according to the rules and regulations of the concerned Regulating Authority.

For subsequent rounds of counselling, the regulations of NBE for inter-se merit will be applicable.

11. Security amount

Before choice filling stage, candidates participating will have to pay refundable / adjustable security amount as under for M.D. / M.S. / Post MBBS DNB / Post MBBS Diploma course:

Rs. 1,00,000 - for UR/EWS/SC/ST/ST-STA/OBC/MBC candidates opting for MD/MS/Post MBBS DNB/ Post MBBS Diploma course on Government Seats in Government Medical Colleges, Govt. Society Medical Colleges, RUHS CMS, Govt. District Hospitals.

Rs. 2,00,000 - for UR/EWS/SC/ST/ST-STA/OBC/MBC candidates opting for MD/MS course on Management Seats in Govt. Society Medical Colleges and RUHS CMS. Candidates depositing Rs. 2,00,000/- will automatically be eligible to fill choices for Govt. Seats in Government Medical Colleges, Govt. Society Medical Colleges, RUHS CMS.

Rs. 5,00,000 - for candidates opting for MD/MS course in Private Medical colleges

[Candidates depositing Rs. 5,00,000/- will automatically be eligible to fill choices for Government Medical Colleges, Govt. Society Medical Colleges, RUHS CMS]

The Security Deposit will be forfeited if a candidate who has been allotted a seat in the Round 2 or subsequent rounds and does not join the respective institution.

Also, the Security Deposit will be forfeited if the admission gets cancelled due to any reason e.g in case the candidate gives wrong information at the time of registration (application form filling) on the basis of which a seat may be allotted and later cancelled by the Board or fails to produce the required essential documents at the time of joining (within stipulated time).

1. If a candidate joins his allotted seat in any round of counselling, his/her security amount will be adjusted in the tuition fee to be deposited for the allotted college.
2. The security amount if not forfeited or adjusted in fee, will be refunded after completion of counseling process, to the concerned bank account from which the security amount is deposited.
3. A candidate allotted a seat in round 1 and does not join the allotted college will be eligible for subsequent round without forfeiture of security amount.
4. Round 1 joined candidate who has not been up-graded during round 2 counseling or has not participated in round 2 may resign without forfeiture of security amount within two days of declaration of round 2 result, failing which he will be considered as joined candidate for round 2 and rules will apply accordingly.
5. A candidate allotted a seat (fresh / upgraded) in round 2 of counseling and does not join the allotted seat, his/her security amount will be forfeited. Such candidate shall not be eligible to participate in further rounds of counselling.
6. Any candidate who retains his round 1 allotted seat (after two days of declaration of result of 2nd round of counselling) and candidates who join their round 2 allotted seat will not be allowed to resign (including returning of original documents) on or before the last date of admissions as scheduled by MCC/NMC.
7. A candidate having joined status on completion of round 2 and willing to participate for upgradation in round 3 will be eligible only on fresh application and on depositing security amount again. His/her earlier deposited security amount will be forfeited.

8. A candidate allotted a seat (fresh / upgraded) in round 3 of counseling and does not join the allotted seat, his/her security amount will be forfeited. Such candidate shall not be eligible to participate in stray vacancy round.
9. A candidate allotted a seat in stray vacancy round does not join the allotted seat **shall be debarred from participating in the State counseling process for next one year**, along with forfeiture of security amount.
10. Candidates having joined status after round 3 will not be allowed to participate in Stray vacancy round.
11. Candidate who joins the course on allotment of round-3 counselling or retains his or her seat (allotted in earlier round) in round-3 or a candidate who joins the course on allotment in stray vacancy round, shall not be allowed to resign the course (including returning of original documents) on or before the last date of admissions as scheduled by MCC/NMC.

Note:

No candidate can join two colleges/institutes at the same time. At the time of round 3 of the allotment process, such candidates who have registered for the state counseling and who have joined other college/institute (as on a specified date) through round 3 All India counseling or any other counseling and hence as per the directions of Hon'ble Supreme Court shall be in-eligible for allotment in State round 3 and stray vacancy round.

Stray Vacancy Round: For participation in stray vacancy round, it is mandatory for eligible candidates to get their documents verified and submit all relevant original documents along with a Bond in prescribed format, with the Board. Candidate whose documents are not verified or who does not submit his /her original documents, will not be allowed to participate in stray vacancy round. Documents of such candidates will be kept by the counselling board after verification. Documents of candidates who do not get any allotment will be returned by the dates notified.

12. Joining at the allotted college

All candidates allotted a seat through State NEET PG 2024 Counselling will have to report in-person at Academic Block, SMS Medical College, Jaipur (at the desk of the allotted college) by the notified date and time.

Round 1

The candidates admitted to all medical colleges will have to deposit **one year tuition fees** with the Chairman of NEET PG Counseling/Admission Board 2024 through **NEFT/RTGS only**. Candidate will then have to deposit the **proof of on-line deposition of fee along with all original documents and requisite bond** to the representative of allotted college (please refer to respective college website). The bank account details of counselling board for online fee deposition will be made available on the website and will be printed on allotment letter of the candidate.

Round 2

The candidates admitted to all medical colleges will have to deposit **one year tuition fees** with the Chairman of NEET PG Counseling/Admission Board 2024 through **NEFT/RTGS only**. Candidate will then have to deposit the **proof of on-line deposition of fee along with all original documents and requisite bond** to the representative of allotted college (please refer to respective college website). The bank account details of counselling board for online fee deposition will be made available on the website and will be printed on allotment letter of the candidate.

Round 1 allotted and joined candidates will be considered for upgradation in round 2. For this upgradation, a round 1 allotted and joined candidate is mandatorily required to fill fresh choices for round 2. In case he/she is allotted a different seat in round 2, his/her seat allotted (and joined) in the round 1 will automatically be vacated (and will be available for allotment to other candidates) and such a candidate will be required to join at the seat allotted during round 2.

Note: Original documents of the upgraded candidates shall be transferred directly to the upgraded college and will not be handed over to the candidate.

Round 3

The candidates admitted to all medical colleges will have to deposit **one year tuition fees** with the Chairman of NEET PG Counseling/Admission Board 2024 through **NEFT/RTGS only**. Candidate will then have to deposit the **proof of on-line deposition of fee along with all original documents and requisite bond** to the representative of allotted college (please refer to respective college website). The bank account details of counselling board for online fee deposition will be made available on the website and will be printed on allotment letter of the candidate.

The candidates who retain round 1 / round 2 allotted seat in round 3 of counseling and candidates who join in round 3 will have to submit **other fees/ charges and complete other formalities** as per guidelines given in the respective college website by the last date of joining of round 3 counseling at the allotted and joined college.

Candidates having joined status upto Round 2 will be considered for upgradation in round 3 on fresh application and on depositing security amount again. For this upgradation, such a candidate is mandatorily required to fill fresh choices for round 3. In case he/she is allotted a different seat in round 3, his/her seat allotted (and joined) in the round 2 will automatically be vacated (and will be available for allotment to other candidates) and such a candidate will be required to join at the seat allotted during round 3).

Important (for all rounds)

Each candidate shall join the allotted college and course within the time as mentioned in the allotment letter issued on-line. There is no provision of extension for joining date. The allotment made will be firm and final. Change of college/course from one place to another is not permitted. Therefore, request for the same would not be entertained by the Admission Board after the allotment.

The selected candidates should bring all the requisite documents in original and also submit an undertaking in **Proforma-1** that the submitted documents are in original along with one set of self-attested copies of documents, at the time of joining at the allotted college, failing which their admission shall stand cancelled. These original documents may be kept with the institution till completion of the course.

The fact that a candidate has applied/ for allotment shall not entitle him/her for allotment/ reallocation as the same will be subject to availability of seat and acceptance of the available seats at the merit of the candidate.

The academic session will commence as per NMC notification, from **20.12.2024**.

The selection for this admission shall be cancelled if the selected candidates do not join at the allotted college and deposit fees upto the stipulated date or whose particulars are found to be incorrect.

The candidates must present the accepted resignation/relieving letter from the institution he/ she is pursuing studies at present, at the time of joining. Failure to do so will result in disqualification for admission.

The selected candidates must also carry all requisite certificates and documents in original and also submit an undertaking that the submitted documents are in original along with self-attested copies of the same, at the time of joining and shall deposit the applicable fees as per the notified procedure and complete other formalities within stipulated time, failing which their admission shall stand cancelled. These original documents may be kept with the institution till completion of the course.

A candidate without original certificates / documents shall not be allowed to take admission at the allotted college under any circumstances. A candidate who has already been admitted in PG course and has deposited his / her certificates in any medical college/ institute / university and participate for counseling (allotment process) with a certificate stating that "his/her original certificates are deposited with the medical college/ institute / university" (except the college allotted through NEET-PG counseling 2024 of Rajasthan state process), will NOT be allowed to take admission at the allotted college.

The colleges shall be provided the list of candidates allotted. The colleges shall verify the credentials of reporting candidates as per this list and check the documents and other required certificates with originals.

The admissions shall be treated as provisional subject to the final decision of any pending case(s) in any court of law, if applicable to these admissions. Further, the provisional status of admission shall stand cleared only after enrolment by the concerned University.

The non-viewing of the websites about allotment information by the candidate shall not be accepted as a ground for non-joining by the scheduled time and date. The candidate's allotment will stand automatically cancelled if he/she does not join IN PERSON at the allotted college as per the notified schedule.

The candidate shall also submit an undertaking (on non-judicial stamp of Rs. 50/ duly notarized) that (a) all documents produced by him/her are in original or (b) in case original documents are lost, stolen or destroyed, the duplicate copy of the documents so submitted are duly issued by the competent authority and (c) if any facts are found false he/she shall be liable for cancellation of his/her admission as well as legal action as may be deemed proper by the State Admission Board / State Government (**Proforma 1**, available in the instruction booklet).

Surety Bond

At the time of allotment, the selected candidates (both All India and State quota) will have to submit a surety bond of Rs. 10.00 lacs (Rupees ten lacs) toward 'not to leave the course in between' (proforma available at the website).

At the time of final joining, a separate Bank Guarantee for Rs. 1.5 lacs and Bond for Rs. 8.5 lacs is to be submitted (surety bond of Rs. 10 lacs submitted earlier will be returned).

Service Bond

The students so selected (for the academic session 2024-25) (except students who are in service of ESI or Central Government or Rajasthan Government or other state Government and already filled service Bond for this purpose) will have to fill a bond amounting to Rs. 25 lacs (Rupees twenty five lacs) for commitment to serve the State Government of Rajasthan for a period of two (2) years (in the applicable bond format) (Refer copy of order no. P7(86)CM/HM/Budget/DME/Acad/2015/8000, dated 12.07.2022 issued by the Government of Rajasthan).

It is clarified that a candidate, who on the date of allotment is in the government service, joins the course after resigning / leaving that service, shall have to fill the above service bond.

At the time of joining, all the original certificates of the candidate shall be deposited in the concerned allotted college towards execution of the bonds. The concerned allotted college shall have the right to retain all the original certificates of the students till compliance of the conditions of the bonds.

14. Conditions relating bond/bank guarantee* and other formalities (applicable for private colleges)

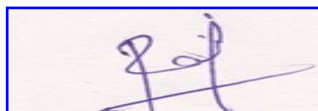

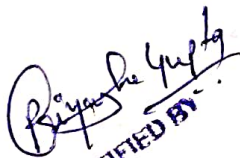
