ORDER

Petitioner's contention is that he is working as a Guest Faculty (Commerce) at Government Arts and Commerce College, Majhauri, District Sidhi (M.P.). He is being prescribed by the College Authorities to join activities of Rashtriya Swayam Sewak Sangh.

It is submitted that the ideology of Rashtriya Swayam Sewak Sangh is not in sync with the ideology of the present petitioner and when he refuses to comply, then he is beaten and threatened. Danger of murder is looming large on his head. He has already make complaints to the Superintendent of Police, Sidhi so also the concerned Town Inspector, but no action is taken on these complaints.

Shri V.S. Choudhary, learned Government Advocate for the State submits that he will direct to Superintendent of Police, Sidhi to look into the complaints, get them examine, and if there is any real thread perception, then will direct the Superintendent of Police to mitigate the same within seven days from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order being passed today.

In view of the aforesaid undertakes furnished by Shri V.S. Choudhary,



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learned Government Advocate for the State, this petition is disposed of, without commenting anything on merits of the claim of the petitioner.
