Learned Deputy Advocate General submits that on account of pendency of subject petitions the effect of amendment dated 25.02.2022 in the Rules framed under M.P. Lokayukt Evam Deputy Lokayukt Adhiniyam, 1981 was not examined.

We note that there is no embargo on the respondents considering the effect of the amendment to the Rules on the case of the petitioner merely on account of pendency of the petitions. Accordingly, respondents shall pass a consequential order in view of the amendment in the Rules and shall also take into account the decision of this Court dated 03.09.2014 in W.P.No.13294/2007 as also order dated 09.12.2014 in W.A.No.896/2014.
