ORDER

% **09.09.2021**

1. This is a petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 482 CrPC for quashing FIR No.183/2021 dated 07.06.2021 registered at Police Station Preet Vihar for offences under Section 354, 354A, 354D and 506 IPC.

2. The allegation against the petitioner is that he was stalking the complainant for long and threatened the complainant to throw acid on her face if she refuses to marry him. It is also alleged that on the day when the instant FIR was lodged the complainant was assaulted and abused by the petitioner.

3. It is stated that the petitioner and the complainant/respondent No.2

have amicably settled the matter by a compromise deed dated 09.06.2021. The complainant/respondent No.2 has filed her affidavit (page No.13 of the paper book) affirming the fact that she has amicably resolved the disputes with the petitioner in the abovementioned FIR.

4. Today, the petitioner has appeared in person and the complainant/respondent No.2 has joined the proceedings through Video Conferencing. They have been identified by SI Manisha, PS Preet Vihar. The complainant states that the petitioner has apologised to her. The petitioner states that he will never repeat such incidents in future. The respondent No.2 states that she has settled all her disputes amicably with the petitioner out of her own free will, without pressure, coercion or undue influence.

5. Taking into account the age of the petitioner and taking into account the fact that the petitioner has full life ahead of him and in view of the apology tendered by the petitioner and his undertaking not to repeat such incidents in the future and in view of the settlement arrived at between the parties, this Court is of the opinion that no useful purpose will be served in continuing the present proceedings. Resultantly, the FIR No.183/2021 dated 07.06.2021 registered at Police Station Preet Vihar for offences under Section 354, 354A, 354D and 506 IPC and the proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed. The parties shall remain bound by the terms of the settlement and the undertaking given to the Court.

6. Looking at the facts and the conduct of the petitioner, this Court is inclined to direct the petitioner to do some social service to atone for his sins.

7. Accordingly, the petitioner is directed to do community service at Lok Nayak Jai Prakash Narayan Hospital for a period of one month i.e. from

15.10.2021 to 16.10.2021. He shall report to the Medical Superintendent, Lok Nayak Prakash Narayan Hospital on 15.10.2021.

8. This Court is also inclined to impose cost of Rs.35,000/-(Rupees Twenty Thousand Only) on the petitioner. The amount shall be paid to the ‘*Army Welfare Fund Battle Casualties*’. Copy of the receipt be filed with the Registry within three weeks from today to show compliance of the order.

9. After completion of one month, a certificate from the Medical Superintendent, Lok Nayak Jai Prakash Narayan Hospital, be also filed to show compliance of the order. In case of any absenteeism/default or any misbehaviour on the part of the petitioner, the same shall be conveyed immediately by the Medical Superintendent, Lok Nayak Jai Prakash Narayan Hospital, to the concerned SHO, who shall in turn inform the learned ASC for the State, for bringing the same to the notice of the Court and for seeking recall of the orders passed today.

10. With the above directions the petition is disposed of.

11. A copy of this order be transmitted to Medical Superintendent, Lok Nayak Jai Prakash Narayan Hospital.
